# THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (No. 2) BILL, 2017

[As introduced in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly during March, 2017]

### THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (No.2) BILL, 2017

### A

#### BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services of the Financial Year 2017-18.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Sixty Eight Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

Short Title

- 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2017
- Issue of **₹ 880310.20 lakh** out of 2. the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial Year, 2017 18.
- From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of *Rupees eight thousand eight hundred three crore ten lakh twenty thousand* only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for the Financial Year 2017-2018 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
- Appropriation3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.

# STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In pursuance of the recommendation of the Governor of Mizoram, this Bill is introduced to provide for the appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, of the moneys required to meet the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund and the grants voted by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly for the expenditure of the State for the period from 1.4.2017 to 31.3.2018.
