

THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (No.2) BILL, 2018

A

BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services of the Financial Year 2018-19.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Sixty Ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2018

Issue of ₹ 967264.30 lakh out of 2. the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial Year, 2018 - 19.

State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of *Rupees nine thousand six hundred seventy two crore sixty four lakh thirty thousand* only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for the Financial Year 2018-2019 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
