OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No. HMG. 3/73/83, the 13th. January, 1982. As in the previous years, silence will be observed and attempt made to bring as large stoppage of work and movement as possible for 2 (two) minutes throughout the Country at 11 A. M. on 30.1.

Struggle for India's freedom.

It has therefore, been decided that:

- (a) The silence will be observed in the capital at Aizawl at 11 A. M. on 30.1.1982 and will last for 2 (two) minutes.
- (b) All workshops, Office works and factories should stop work as far as practicable.
- (c) All India Radio should stop broadcasting and all traffics on road should come to a standstill.
- (d) To indicate the commencement of 2 (two) minutes silence, the siren installed at the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl will be sounded from 10.59 hours till 11.00 hours. On hearing of which all persons should stand up and observe silence for 2 minutes. After the 2 minutes silence is over "all clear" siren will again be sounded from 11.02 hours till 11.03 hours.

It is requested that all concerned may strictly observe the above instructions and also bring to the notice of the staff working under them. This may please be treated as standing instructions on the subject and same procedure followed every year in future.
