## NOTIFICATION

N. A. 12013(7)/80 -APT(8) : the 3rd March, 1982. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt. 21st January, 1972 and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Administrator of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Mizoram Secretariat (Group 'A') Recruitment rules, 1977 (issued under notification No. ABR 84/77/23-28 dt. 29. 8. 79), namely :—

1. 1 These rules may be called the Mizoram Secretariat (Group 'A') Recruitment First Amendment Rules, 1982.

2 They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the schedule of the Mizoram Secretariat (Group 'A') Recruitment Rules, 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules) for existing entries under column 5 for the posts of Under Secretary, the following proviso shall be substituted :—

“Selection Post.”

3. In the schedule of the said rules, for the existing entries under column 10 (a) for the post of Under Secretary, the following proviso shall be substituted :—

“Eight posts or not less than 25 per cent of posts (whichever number is greater) shall be filled by Officers belonging to MCS Grade-II”.

4. In the schedule of the said rules, for the existing entries under column 10 (b) for the post of Under Secretary, the following proviso shall be substituted :—

“The remaining posts (but not more than 75 per cent of the total posts) shall be filled by promotion from Superintendents in the scale of Rs. 550-900/- failing which by transfer on deputation”.

5. In the schedule of the said rules; for the existing entries under column 11 for the post of Under Secretary, the following proviso shall be substituted :—

(a) Promotion :— Superintendents who have rendered not less than 5 years service in the grade”.

(b) Members of Civil Service Officers in their grade pay.

(c) Transfer on deputation :— Officers from Central or State Governments/U.T. Administrations holding analogous posts. Period of deputation ordinarily not exceeding three years”.
