The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1982

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator)
on the 29th. March, 1982)

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1982—83.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1982. **Short title.**
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, there may be paid **Issue of Rupees 91,47,73,000/-** of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of ninety-one crores, forty seven lakhs and seventy eight thousand rupees, towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1982—83 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. **from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram for the financial year 1982—83.**
3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year. **Appropriation.**
