NO. PDC/LJ-3/81/88-96 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 28 , read with subesection (3) of sectivn 3, of the Pawi Autonomous District Council (Villige Councils) Act, 1974, the Executive Committee of the Pawi District Council, with the previous approval of the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) of the Uxion territory of Mizorars; is pleased to make the following rules, namely :-

THE PANI AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL (ELECTION TO VILLAGE COUNCILS) RULES, 1981

## CHAPTER I

Preliminary

1. Short title, extent and commencement:-
(1) These rules may be called the Pawi Autonomous District Council (Election to Village Conncils) Rules, 1981.
(2) They shall extend to the whole of the Pawi Autonomous District
(3) They shall come into force at once.
2. Definitions :- la these rules uoless the context otherwise requires, -
(1) "constituency" means so much of the ares as is included within the jurisdiction of a Village Council;
(2) "Court" means the Courts, except the Village Court constituted under the provisions of the Pawi Autonomous District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1974 ;
(3) "District" means the Pawi Autonomous District;
(4) "District Council' means the District Council of the Pawi Autonomous District;
(5) "election" means an election to fill a seat or seats in the Village Council;
(6) "elector" means yerson whose name is for the time being entered in the electoral roll ;
(7) "electoral roll" means the electoral roll as prepared by the Executive Committee under sub-rule (3) of rule 3;
(8) "Executive Committee" means the Executive Committee of the Pawi District Council;
(9) "Gazette" means the Mizoram Gazette;
(10) 'Presiding Officer" means the Officer appointed for conducting the clection in a polling station;
(11) "Returning Officer" means any Officer appointed for conducting the election to a constituepsy;
(12) "Village" means a Village or Villages declared to form a Village Council.

## CHAPTER II <br> General Provisions

3. Holdine of general election:-
(1) All elections to the Village Councils shall be held under the provisions of these rules.
(2) There shall be an electoral rool for every constituency,
(3) The latest electoral roll for election to the Distrlct Councll as may be amended by the Executive Committee to onsit those who have ceased to be residents of the Village shall be the electoral roll for election to a Village Council :
(4) ise Executive Committee shall, by notification in the Gazette, fix the number of seats for each constituency to form a Village Council.
4. Appointment of Officers:-. .
(1) Tre Exesutive Committer shall appoint a Returning Orficer, wbo will ald furction as Presiding Offlicer, and also Polling Officers, to peform the functions fo elocion to exch Village Council :

Provided that if a Polling Officer, owing to illeess or atle ancoodable caus ix in ble to ferform the functions of the Polliag Off.cer. Feturning Offic my arpoitand person who is present at the roling station cher then a perso who ias bren employed by or on behalf of or has been ornerwise werking for, carddete in or about the election to be the Polling Ofiricer, ard inform th Excutise Committe accordingly.
(2) : the Returbing Officer, woo is also the Presiding Offer, cwing to iilness o other uo voidab'e cause, is uable to perf m the said farctions, mis mations sba be performed by such Polling Officer as tas teen previovaly autlorised by th Exterive Committee to perform suci functions.
5. Date of clection:-

The Executive Committee shall, by notification, call uponthe coustluency concerre to dect the number of Members to be retursed ard shall also fypoint the date detes fur such eleation in each constituency simattereously or consecutively, accordin to convenience. The Returniag Officer may, however, cause solection to be he 0 guct dare 2 fter the date appointed by the Executive Con nitee in respect of ay constituency as a special case when the appointed date conot be observed do is wote unforeseen inconvenience :

Providad that the change of date shall be notified to the constitacecy concerne by to Returaing Officer at least seven days before the date so fixat for election.
6 . El a tion of the names of Members of Village Council:-
te names of Members elected and of these nomingted for tie various Villag Conacils stall be published in the Gazette as soon as may be ciler the clection is ove
7. Filling of vacancies:-
(1) A seat or seats and a casual vacancy or vacancies in the Village Council Councils in respect of a nominated seat or seats shall be fitied by the Executiv Committee by domination.
(2) A seat or seats and a casual vacancy or vacancies in tis Vilage Council c Coumbils in respect of elected sent or sats shall be filled by beateationa
8. Disqualified Members:-

The met of aty blewber found to be disquálifed after is elec ion, may be declare vocut by the Exacuive Committe ard filled urder the rrovions of these rules,
9. Duties of Returning Officer:-

It sball be the general duty of the Returaing Officer at any Village Council election to do all such acts and things as may be necessary for effectually conducting the election in the manner provided under these rules and bis decision shall be final.
10. Power of the Executive Committee :-

The Executive Committee may prescribe such forms as may be necessary for the conduct of the elections.

## CHAPTER III CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION.

11. Qualification of candidates for election:-

Any person whose name is included in the electoral roll of the constituency and who is not otherwise disqualified under section 4 of the Pawi Autonomous District Couocil (Village Councils) Act, 1974, may offer bimself as a candidate for election to a Village Council and sball inform the Returoirg Officer, in writing, of his intention to do so by a particular date to be notified in this behalf by the Returning Officer.
12. Scrutiry of candidyture:-

Tre scrutiny of candidature shall be taken up by the Returning Officer in the respestive constituency on a date and time to be notified by him.
13. Withdrawal of candidature:-

The Returning Officer may accept the witbdrawal of any candidate before the scrutiny of the candidature takes place and refund the security deposit as hereioafter provided.
14. Security deposit, its refurnd or forfeiture :-

A candidate shall furnish a security deposit of Rs. 25/- to the Returning Officer along with bis application for candidature which will be refunded in the ovent of the withdrawal of candidature or at the earliest date after the conclusion of the election.

Provided that the deposit shall be forfeited to the District Council if at an election where poll has been tiken the candidate is not elected and the aumbe: of valid votes polled hy him does not exceed one-sixth of the total vumber of valld votes polled by all the candidates or in the case of election of more tain one member at the election ofe-sixth of the total number of valid votes so folled divided by the number of menibers to be elected,
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(1) The Executive Commitee shall appoint a Returning Officer, who will a freton as Fresiding Officer, and also Polling Officers, to peffrin lie functions chaion to eaco Villzge Council :

Provided that if a Polling Officer, owing to illness or rive anevoidable cau is in ble to perform the functions of the Polligg Officer, ste Returoing Offic dey appoint any person who is present at the roling station oblet then a pers who bas been employed by or on bahalf of or has been othersice working for cradiate in or about tie election to be the Polling Oficer, and inform Excutive Committee aciordingly.
(2) the Returging Officer, who is also the Fresidng Offer cwiag to illaess oner une widable cause, is unable to perferm the sad functue, wo ractions st be performed by such Polling Officer as bas been previctsiy authorised by Exesitive Committee to perform such functions.
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15. Election by symbol:-

Each candidate sball select a symbol out of those prescribed in tie Appendix to represent bim in the election and the elecion stiall be condacted by symbol system, If ir ore capdidates than oac selected satie syabot, the Returcing Officer shall decide by lot to which of taise candidtes tae syaboi will be assigned. The decision of tie keturning Oificer is assigning a!y symbol to a casdidite utder this rule, shall be final.
16. Preparecion and pubiation of cha hist of valid condijates:As socn as may be, after the scrutiny of the cazdidatures, if the aumber of valid candidtes exceeds that of the seats to be filled tise Returning Officer shall compile a list showicg the names of the valic candiates and the symols sissigned to each candidate and publish it in the manser be thanks fit asd a poll sall be taken in the majoer prescribed in those rules.
17. (1) When number of valid caodidates is equal to nunber of seats:-

If the number of cabdiates in constutuefy equal to tee number of elected seats to be filled, the Returniog Officer sha:l foribwith deci re all such candidates to be elected to fill those seats in the Vilage Council.
(2) When the number of velid cecd.dates is less tuar number of seats:-

If the ounber of valid cardidaits is less then the number of seats to be filled the Returning Officer saell declore all such candidates to be clected to fill as many of those seats and to executive Cotranitee seall, by nolfic.tion. call upoas the constitueacy to elect a persch or persous to fill the remaining seat or seats, as the case may be, witain such tince as may be specified in the rotification.

## CHAPIER IV

Voting
18: Arrangement of voting:-
There shall be only ooe polivg ststion for each consítuency. The Returving Officer or any officer appoinied by him shah make all
the election.
19. Election agett:-

One election agent of a cardidate, appointed in writing and submitted to the Returning Officer, shall be admissible into the polling booth in the case of the candidate absenting bimself from the pollidg station.
20. No vote by proxy :-

Every voter shall record his/her vote at the polling booth by him/herself only and no votes hy proxy or othernise shall be accepted.
21. Hours of poll :-

Tbe Returning Officer shall fix the bours for poliing.
22. Ballot boxes:-

Just before polling is started the empty ballot boxe: with their respective symbols and cames of the candidates fixed of them, sball be shown to the persons present at the polling station. The ballot boxes vill then be closed by pasting with an adhesive and wax sealing device.
23. Ballot paper:-

Each votes shall be given as many ballint papers as there are elected seats: The Executive Committee may direct that tefore the ballot papers are delivered to a voter at a polling station, such official marks as may be specified in this bebalf, shall be given on the ballot papers and the official mark so specified shall be kept secret.
24. Record of rote :-

Each voter shall record tis vote/votes by dropping only one ballot paper in each box containing the symbol assigned to the candidare/candidates of his choice:

Provided that if for any reason, a voter does not watt to use bis ballot paper/ papers, the voter concerned must return the same which shall be cancelled and warked "refused" on the counterfoil/ cousterfcils:

Provided further that if an elector gives more than ore vote to any ore candidate, then at the time of counticg of votes, not more than one of the votes given by him to such cardidate, shali te teke into accout ard all other votes given by bim to sucb candidate, stall be rejected as void.
25. Helping a voter :-

If owing to blindness or other infirmity, a voter is unabie to read the symbol on the ballot box or is plysically incapable of retting tie tallot paper into the ballot box, the Presiding Ofticer of the polligg station shall enter the polling compartment with sucb voter, ascertain from the voter the candidate or candidates he desires to vote for and shall put the ballot papers in tre bellot box or bexes of sucb cardidate or candidates in accordance with the wiskes of such voter. The Presiding Officer shall have this done with as much secrecy as is possible and shall keep a record of such instances.
26. Spoilt ballot parper:-

If a ballot paper happens to be spoilt before it is used due to any reason, another ballot paper may be obtained surrendering the spoilt ballot paper which shall be cancelled with its counterfoil.
27. Suspeasion of votiog:-

If due to any reason beyond contrel, the poling of votes has to be stopped resultin in the dispersion of the voter; bed the eavdidates and the clection officers with the bours prescribed and before all i.le ruters inave polled, the poling sball b suspoaded and ballot boxes closed by $p$ sting with an admesive and wax sealin device till they are re-opened when poilng is contirued as decided by the seaio most election Officer presint.
23. Closige ballot boxes afer poll:-

As soon as practicabic afier the closure of the poll, the Presiding Officer shall, i the rresence of the candidates or their agents who may be prasent, close the bill boses and seal ther, and shall retain the b:lot $b$ oxes in safe custody until th commencement of the counting of votes.

CHAPTER V<br>Countiog of Votes

29. Countiag of votes:-

Counting of votes shall be teken un as soos as possibie after the close of the po and the Returning Officer shall inform the date, place and tine o counting to th cancidstes or thoir election agents. The Returoing Officer may appo ot any perso or $p=i$ rons as may be necessary to assist bia in the counting of voies.
30. Authozised persons at the counting of votes:--

No persua sball be allowed to bs presest at the counting of yotes except the car didate or his election agent where the candidate is absent exd the Returning Office aid such persons as the Returning Officer may have appointed to assist him in the countiag of vote.
31. Suspersion of cousting of votes:-

If due to acy preson beyon control, tie countigg of votes has to be delayed for an period resulting in the dispersion of tha c : adidates and tie election staff from th booth or the place appoioted in its stead, the bailot boxes sball be closed by pastin with an adkesive and wasealing device. The boxes shall be reopeded at the nex countin of votes.
32. Equality of votes:-

In the case of equality of votes the Returbing Officer shail decide membershi between those candidates by drawing lots.

33: Publication of election result :-
The lint of candidates elect shall be published in the Gazette.

CHABRER VI<br>Eection Petidus

34. Submissice of aleatios petitions:

A petition challengiag the vaidity of ay clection may be sabmited by a randidate
 purpose, within thirty days of the decs:ton of the election results ty tue Returning Officer of the constituercy corccioce, antacting to the petition, en eificial recenpt
 of bearing of the perition les been acid. sucte deposir sambll be forfeted to the District Council incose the petion ion. li, nownesio tee petitica suceeds, the deposit shall be refundea.
35. Witadrawal oi eleation paition:If an election petiou is witsarawn pition it (fouteen) deys from the date of filing
 (fomreen) days from the date of flege te securiv, deposit slail be forfeited to the District Couscil.
36. Disposal of election patition :--

 Exeutive Commiten, wherapus he Exumbe iombiche shill notify tue decision of tie tribunal.

37. Corrupt prectices:-
(1) The following shall be deneed is be cermpt practice fir the purposes of election to the Village Council :-
(!) Bribery; (ii) Utdue iffluence; (iii) Personation;
(iv) Removal of ballot paper; (v) Publications of false statenent;
(vi) Use of, or appeal to relizious and national symbols as defined in Chapter IX of Part IV of the Mizorara Autonomons District Councils (Constitution and Conduct oî Business of District Councils) Rules, 1974.
(2) The corrupt practices enumerated in subrule (1) will entail disqualification for a voter or candidate or his agent, as the cuse may be.

CHAPTER VIIT,
Electord ${ }^{4}$ Offetices:
38. Public meeting:-

No person shall convene, bold, or participarijn, sny public meeting or zonyass for self or for sny candidate on the date on wbinh poll is taken for clection to Village Councils.
39. Maintenance of secrecy:-

Every officer, clerk or agent or other persoarmbonforms any duty in connection witio the recording or counting of votes at an electiop sball maintaia the secrecy of the voting.
40. Prohibition of interference while polling :-

No person sball interfere in any way with the work of the Returaing O乌icer or other officers employed for the conduct of elections' to Village Councils.
41. Contravention of any provisions:-

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of rules 38 to 40 shall be punishable with fine which may extend to five huadred rupees.

## CHAPTER IX <br> Power of Beturoing Officer

42. No civil court shall have jurisdiction to question the legalit of any action taken or of any decision given by the Returning Off.cer or by any other $p \in$ froo appointed under these rules in connection with an election.

## CHAPTER X

Repeal
43. Repeal and Savings:-
(1) The Pawi-Lakher Regional Council (Electios to Village Councils) Rules, 1955 are hereby repealed.
(2) Notwitbstanding such repeal; any action taken or proceedings made under those rules shall, in so far as it is not iaconsistant with the provisions of these rules, be deemed to have been taken or made under these rules.
