OBITUARY

No. MAL. 56 81/82/49, the 2nd July, 1982. The Mizoram Legislative Assembly have learnt with deep sorrow the sudden and premature death of Pu R. Zadinga, MLA on the night of June 15, 1982 at Village Lungphun at the hands of the MNF insurgents.

Pu R. Zadinga S o Pu Dengkhuma Rivung was born on May 12, 1947. He had his education at Phuldungsei and Aizawl. In 1971, he appeared in the HSLC Examination as a private candidate and was placed in the 2nd Division. He was graduated from the Pachbunga Memorial College in 1976.

In 1973 he served as Primary Investigator in the Economic & Statistic Department for about six months. In the same year he joined the Supply Department as Sub-Inspector of Supply and resigned this post in December, 1980.

In 1971 he married Lalthlamuani with whom he had two sons and two daughters.

In 1981 he became the president of Bungkawn People's Conference Unit and in the Village Council election held in February, 1982 he was elected as member from Bungkawn. Again in the same year, he was elected to the Mizoram Legislative Assembly on P.C. ticket from Phuldungsei Constituency in the bye-election.

He was an important and active member in the Presbyterian Church of the Bungkawn Veng and was associated with a number of social Organisations.
