AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1983—84.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

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| 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1984. | Short title. |
