AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1984—85.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 1984.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred and twenty nine crores seventy two lakhs and fifty one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1984—85 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rs.1,29,72,51,000.00 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory for the financial year 1984--85.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
