NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/52/80-APT (B), the 5th October, 1984 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Articles 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Drivers and Handyman in various Officer under the Govt. of Mizoram namely:—

- 1. Short title and 1. These Rules may be called the Mizoram Drivers and Commencement Handyman Recruitment Rules, 1984.
 - 2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
- 2. Application The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Col. 1 of the Schedule here to annexed.
- 3. Numbers of posts The number of the said posts, their classification and classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Schedule aforesaid.
- 4. Method of rectt. The age limit qualifications and other matters relating age limit and other to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 qualification. to 13 of the said schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

- No rerson.
- a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living
- t) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage in permission under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

- 6. Training Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training or pass such Deathd Departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time, artmental Examination.
- 7. Power to relax. Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with Mizoram Selection Board, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 8. Reserva. Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions tion, other required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled concessions Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 9. Repeal All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of and saving Assem or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in persuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt.21.1.1972, Govt. of Mizoram Notification No. MAF/B/14/72-73/10 dt. 19.3.1975 (Gazette publication dt.21.3.1975), are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders-ancilary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
