No. H-14012/1/85 L&J/7, the 29th March, 1985. The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Act No. 1 of 1985.
The Mizoram Appropriation Act, 1985.

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram on the 26th March, 1985).

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1984—85

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-Sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation Act, 1985.
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of forty crores ninety seven lakhs and seventy three thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1984—85 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
