Introduction of 5-day week in the Administrative Offices.

The question of introduction of 5-day week in the administrative offices has been under consideration of the Govt. of Mizoram for sometime now, in the context of improving efficiency in administration and the felt-needs of the people. The matter has also been discussed with the Federation of Mizoram Govt. Employees & Workers. Taking into consideration the guide lines contained in Govt. of India's O.M.NO. 13/4/85-JCA dated the 21st May 1985 and also the views of the Govt. employees, it has been decided to introduce 5-day week in the administrative offices of the Govt. of Mizoram with effect from 3rd June 1985. The offices would now work for 5-days a week from Monday to Friday, with all Saturdays as closed. The working hours per day will be 9 a.m to 4.30 p.m without any lunch break.

All the Secretaries and Heads of Departments are requested to bring these instructions to the notice of all the employees working under their control.
