In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1932 (Act No. 23 of 1932), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare that all offences punishable under sections 186, 188, 189, 190, 228, 295-A 298, 505, 506 and 507 of the Indian Penal Code (Act No. 45 of 1860), when committed in the area specified below, shall notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act No. 2 of 1974), be cognizable.

This Notification shall remain in force for a period of six months.
