THE AIRCRAFT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1985 No. 7 of 1985

Promulgated by the President in the Thirty Sixth Year of the Republic of India
An Ordinance further to amend the Aircraft Act, 1943.

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the Powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution; the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance :—

Short title

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Aircraft (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Act 22 of 1934 2. In the Aircraft Act, 1934, for section 14, the following section shall be substituted, namely:—

Rules to be made after publication "14. Any power to make rules conferred by this Act is subject to the condition of the rules being made after previous publication :

Provided that the Central Government may, in the public interest, by order in writing dispense with the condition of previous publication in any case."

THE PAYMENT OF BONUS (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE. 1985
No. 8 of 1985

Promulgated by the President in the Thirty Sixth Year of the Republic of India.
An Ordinance further to amend the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965.

WHEREAS, Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution and of all other power enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Payment of Bonus (Second Amendment) Ordinance 1985

(2) It shall come into force at once.

(3) The Amendments made by this Ordinance in the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) shall in relation

to a factory or other establishment to which the principal Act applies, have effect and be deemed always to have had effect in respect of the accounting year commencing on any day in the year 1984 and in respect of every subsequent accounting year.

Explanation :- The words and expressions which are used in this sub-section and which are defined in the principal Act shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the principal Act.

2. In section 2 of the principal Act, in clause (13), for the words "one thousand and six hundred rupees", the words "two thousand and five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

3. In the principal Act, after section 11, the following section shall be inserted, namely :-

Calculation of
bonus with
respect to
certain em-
ployees.

"12. Where the salary or wages of an employee exceeds one thousand and six hundred rupees per mensem, the bonus payable to such employee under section 10 or as the case may be, under section 11, shall be calculated as if his salary or wage were one thousand and six hundred rupees per mensem."
