NOTIFICATION

No. FOR. 335/85-86/98, the 17th February, 1986. The Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to create one new Forest Division to be known as Tlabung Forest Division under Forest Department with its headquarters at Tlabung comprising of the existing territorial Forests Ranges, namely, Tlabung Range, Buarpui Range, Lungsen Range, Chawngte Range and Marpara Range by curving out of the existing Lunglei Forest Division.

The territorial jurisdiction of this new Tlabung Forest Division is as follows :-

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF TLABUNG FOREST DIVISION :

NORTH : The Northern boundary starts from the meeting point of International boundary of India and Bangladesh at the source of Sazuk lui, the boundary line runs directly forwards east to meet at the surf curve of river Tuilianpui upto the confluence of Mar river. It then follows Marlui upstream following the inter District boundary of Aizawl and Lunglei District curving out from Marlui at the crossing point of Mar lui through Pukzing and Laisawral then follows along the inter District boundary and ultimately falls to Tlawng river.

EAST : It then follows Tlawng river upstream towards South till it reaches the confluence of boundary stream of Serte and Lungdai village. Then it follows the said stream upto its source and comes up to the inter village boundary which is also the tributary of Khawkraw lui. It then falls to Khawkraw lui and meets river De. It then follows De downstream and meets Kau river. It then runs along Kau river and ultimately falls to Phairuang river. From there the boundary follows Phairuang river upstream upto Lunglei to Tlabung BRTF Road. Then it follows Phairuang river further upstream upto the confluence of Ruangte lui. It then follows Ruangte lui upstream upto its source (Chithar village). Then it follows inter village foot path towards South from Chithar to Vaisam, to Mautlang then towards Diltlang where it meets Kawrang lui on way before reaching Diltlang. It then follows Kawrang lui downstream along the inter District boundary of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui District upto Chawngte river.

SOUTH : The boundary then follows Chawngte river which is the district boundary of Chhimtuipui and Lunglei and meets Tuichawng river. It then follows Tuichawng river downstream along the inter district boundary it then bifurcates from Tuichawng river towards West following the same inter District boundary of Chhimtuipui and Lunglei up to international boundary between India and Bangladesh.

WEST : The boundary then follows Indo-Bangladest boundary along Sazuk lui upto its source and after crossing saddle it proceeds further towards North starting from the source of Tawngkawrlui it follows Tawngkawrlui downstream upto its starting point.

The Ranges and Beats under Tlabung Forest Division are in the ANNEXURE 'A' and boundary description of Ranges are in the ANNEXURE B,C,D,E & F.

The Tlabung Forest Division shall be deemed to have come into being with effect from 19th February, 1986.

ANNEXURE 'B'

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF TLABUNG RANGE WITH ITS HEAD-QUARTERS AT TLABUNG

NORTH : The boundary starts from the Indo-Bangladesh boundary at Sazuk lui three miles south of L. Suri village. The boundary turn easternly direction cutting through Puankhai Reserved Forest two miles south of Puankhai village and meets river Tuilianpui.

EAST : The boundary follows river Tuilianpui downstream upto the confluence of river Tuichawng. Then the boundary follows river Tuichawng upstream till it reaches Chhimtuipui and Lunglei District boundary.

SOUTH : From the river Tuichawng the boundary follows Chhimtuipui and Lunglei District boundary till it reaches river Khawthlangtuipui. Then the boundary follows river Khawthlangtuipui downstream upto confluence of Sazuklui.

WEST : Then the boundary follows Sazuklui following Indo-Bangladesh boundary upstream and meets the starting point.

ANNEXURE 'C'

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF CHAWNGTE RANGE WITH ITS HEAD-QUARTERS AT CHAWNGTE

NORTH : From the meeting point of Chhawhchhilui and Phairuang the boundary follows river Phairuang upstream upto the confluence of Ruangte lui. Then the boundary follows Ruangte lui upstream upto its source and meats Chithar village.

EAST : The eastern boundary of Chawngte Range follows the eastern boundary of Tlabung Forest Division.

SOUTH : The southern boundary of Chawngte Range follows Lunglei and Chhimtuipui District, boundary which is also boundary of Tlabung Forest Division upto Chawngte village.

WEST : Then the boundary follows the inter District boundary between Chhim^tuipui and Lunglei at Tuichawng river till it reaches the boundary turn westwards. From thence the boundary follows river Tuichawng downstream till it reaches the confluence of Rangte lui i. e. the starting point.

ANNEXURE 'D'

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF LUNGSEN RANGE WITH HEADQUARTERS AT LUNGSEN

NORTH : Starting from the confluence of Tuilianpui and Tuikawi (Tuikawichhuah) The boundary follows Tuikawi upstream upto its source i.e. Hruizam Village. It then goes towards east after crossing the saddle and meets the source of Zairang stream. It follows Zaireng lui downstream upto Kau river.

EAST : It follows Kau river downstream upto the confluence of Phairuang river. It then follows Phairuang river upstream upto the confluence of Chhawhchhi lui.

SOUTH : It then follows Chhawhchhi lui upstream upto its source till it reaches Khawth'ir tlang and crosses the inter village footpath between Lungrang and Lungsen. Then the boundary turns westernly direction and falls to Rangte lui. It then follows Rangte lui downstream upto its mouth i.e. Tuichawng river.

WEST : The boundary thence follows river Tuichawng downstream following Chhimtuipui and Lunglei District boundary. Then the boundary proceeds northwards following river Tuichawng downstream till it reaches river Tuilianpui upstream upto the confluence of Tuikawilui i.e. the starting point.

ANNEXURE 'E'

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF BUARPUI RANGE :

NORTH : Starting from the meeting point of river Mar and Zampui or the last point of Lunglei and Aizawl District boundary along the river Mar, the boundary runs easternly direction along the inter District boundary line between Aizawl and Lunglei District upto river Tlawng.

EAST : The boundary runs uptsream towards south along the river Tlawng till it reaches the village boundary between Lungdai and Serte Village.

SOUTH : The boundary follows the said boundary stream (upstream) towards west upto saddle crossing inter-village footpath between Lungdai and Serte and then meets" the source of another stream which is the boundary stream of Lungdai and Serte village. It then follows the said stream till it meets rivers De. It then follows river De till it reaches river Kau (Kau chhuah) WEST : The boundary follows river Kau towards northernly direction (upstream) upto the confluence of Tuisen (Tuisenchhuah). It proceeds further towards north following the said Kau river upstream upto its source and reaches at the saddle near Thorang tlang. It then meets Luangphum lui and follows the said stream (downstream) and ultimately meets Mar river. It then follows Mar river (uptream) upto the starting point.

ANNEXURE 'F'

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF MARPARA RANGE WITH THE HEAD-QUARTERS AT MARPARA

NORTH : Starting from the source of Sazuk lui it follows the international boundary between Bangladesh and India towards east up to Tuilianpui. It then follows River Tuilianpui upstream up to the confluence of Mar river. It then follows Mar river upstream up to the confluence of Lungphum lui.

EAST : It follows Lungphum lui upstream upto saddle near Thorangtlang and crosses the said saddle and falls to the source of Kau River. It follows Kau river downstream upto the confluence of Zaireng stream (Zairengchhuah).

SOUTH : It then follows Zairenglui upstream upto its source near the Hruizam village. It then falls at the source of Tuikawilui towards west following the river downstream upto river Tuilianpui. From the river Tuilianpui it goes directly towards the West (about two miles south of Phankhai village) parallel to latitude line and meets Sazuk river.

WEST : It follows Sazuk river upstream following international boundary of India and Bangladesh and meets the starting point.
