AN ACT.

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1985-86.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-Seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:
