No. A. 12018/35/80-APT(B), the 25th July, 1986. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st. January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Public Relation Officer, Senior Information Officer, Senior Press Information Officer, Senior Editor under Information, Public Relation and Tourism Deptt. Govt. of Mizoram.

- . These Rules may be called the Mizoram Information, Public Relation & Tourism Deptt. (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules 1986.
 - 2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application : The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Col. 1 of the Annexure I hereto annexed.
- 3. Numbers of posts, classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure I aforesaid.

4. Method of rectt. age limit and other qualification :

The age limit qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time. 5. Disqualification :

- a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.

b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person from the grounds for doing exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

Power to relax: Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with Mizoram Selection Board, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Reservation Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions tion, other required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the Scheduled castes, the Scheduled castes is the scheduled castes. Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
