ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA

NOTIFICATION

S.O.— Whereas by its order dated 18th February, 1987, the Election Commission of India has directed that, pending the determination of the main dispute whether the Indian Congress (J), a State Party in the State of Haryana, has ceased to exist or not,—

- (i) the group led by Shri H.S. Bhalla be called and known as “Indian Congress (J) — Bhalla Group” ;
- (ii) the symbol “Scales within a rectangle” be reserved for the said party.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (b) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, the Election Commission of India hereby makes the following amendment in its notification No. 56/84—1, dated the 13th November, 1984, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3 (iii), dated the 16th November, 1984, and as amended from time to time, namely :—

In Table 2 appended to the said notification, against the State of Haryana, for the entry “Indian Congress (J)..... Scales” under columns 2 and 3 of the said Table, the following entries shall be substituted :—

- “1. Indian Congress (J)Scales
(Dispute pending before Commission)
- 1A. Indian Congress (J)— Bhalla Group.....Scales within a rectangle”
