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### NOTIFICATION

No. G. 11011/2/87-FBT/9, the 8th May, 1987. Ministry of Finance in the Government of India vide their letter No. F. 8 (1)-FCD/85 dated 17.3.1987 have released Grant-in-aid for upgradation of Standard of Administration amounting to Rs. 5.10 crores in the light of the recommendation of the Eighth Finance Commission. The amount is to be utilised during the 2 (two) years 1987-89. The grants is to be utilised for the following 9 (nine) Sectors for upgradation of Standard of Administration.

In terms of para 12.73 (ii) of Chapter XII of the Report of the Eighth Finance Commission, the State Government is required to constitute a State Level Empowered Committee to cause formulation of suitable Plans of action.

The Governor of Mizoram is therefore pleased to constitute the State Level Empowered Committee (SLEC) consisting of the following members with the term of office for a period of 2 (two) years with immediate effect.

## FUNCTIONS & DUTIES

1. To draw up Plans of action both in physical and Financial terms for submission to the Inter-Ministerial Empowered Committee (IMEC).
2. To sanction schemes, provide funds and monitor the progress.
3. To alter the Physical targets contained in the upgradation grants and to review the Physical and financial progress of utilisation of the grants.
4. The Committee should meet frequently not less than once in two months.
