NOTIFICATION

NO. DCA/A-31/85/P/36, the 31st July 1987. Whereas instances of irregularities, misutilisation of fund, non-observation of financial rules and procedure, and also violation of statutory provisions committed by the Pawi Autonomous District Council in its day to day function and discharge of official duties have come to the notice of the Government. Even in administration and supervision of few village Councils within its jurisdiction, basic democratic principle have not been followed by the said Pawi Autonomous District Council.

And whereas the Governor of Mizoram is satisfied that a situation has arisen in which the administration of the Pawi Autonomous District cannot be carried on in accordance with the provision of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-para (2) of paragraph 16 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India the Governor of Mizoram hereby assumes to himself all powers and functions vested in and exercisable by the said Pawi Autonomous District Council with effect from 1st August 1987 for a period of six months or till the next General election of the Pawi District Council, whichever is earlier.

The Governor of Mizoram is further pleased to order that during the aforesaid period all the powers and functions so assumed by the Governor will be discharged by the Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil), Lawngtlai on his behalf.

Consequent to the assumption of the powers and function of the Pawi District Council by the Governor, the Executive Committee as a whole and Chief Executive Member and the Executive Members of the said Council shall cease to hold office and functioning as such during the aforesaid period.
