NOTIFICATION

No. DCA/E-187/87/20 : the 10th December 1987. Whereas by Notification No. DCA/E-187/87/6 Dt. 10.11.87 issued in pursuance of Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 7 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules 1974, the Governor of Mizoram has been pleased to allocate 11 (eleven) elected seats for the District Council for the Chakma Autonomous District.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of rule 7 of the said Rules, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to direct that :—

(I) the Chakma Autonomous District shall be divided for the purpose of Elections to the Chakma District Council into 11 (eleven) territorial constituencies as specified in column 2 of the table below

(II) The extent of each constituency shall be as shown in the corresponding entries in column 4 thereof and polling stations for each of the constituencies shall be as shown in column 3 and

(III) each such constituencies shall elect one member.
