NOTIFICATION

NO. ESS/MBSE/10/87/17. the 17th Feb, 1988. In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (vii) of sub-section (2) of Section 22 of the Mizoram Board of School Education Act, 1975 (Mizoram Act.No.2 of 1976) read with clauses (vii) of section 11 of the said Act, the Mizoram Board of School Education is pleased to make the following regulation namely :

- Short title and commencement. 1. (1) These regulations may be called the Mizoram Board of School Education (Constitution of Awards/Prizes to meritorious students) Regulations, 1988.
- (2) They shall come into force on such date as the Board may by notification publish it.
- Definitions 2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires.
- (a) "Act" means the Mizoram Board of School Education Act, 1975, (Mizoram Act No. 2 of 1976).
- (b) "Board" means the Mizoram Board of School Education, established under the Act;
- (c) "Examination" means Primary, Middle, High Schools and Professional or Vocational School and Teachers Training Institution Examinations whether examination in single subject or compartmental examinations conducted by the Board;
- (d) "Head of Institution" means the head of the institution by whatever name he or she may be designated;
- (e) "Institution" means any recognised Primary, Middle, High, Professional or Vocational School or Teachers' Training Institute in Mizoram;

(f) "President" means the President of the Board;

(g) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Board.

Scope 3. These regulations shall apply to Institutions in Mizoram and candidates who appeared at the public examinations conducted by the Board.

Categories of Awards/Prizes (4) For the purpose of these regulations there shall be the following categories of Awards/Prizes.

(a) Primary School Leaving Certificate Examination.

(b) Middle School Leaving Certificate Examination.

(c) High School Leaving Certificate Examination.

(d) Diploma in Teachers Educations (Middle Section & Primary Sections) of Teachers' Training Institute.

These Awards/ Prizes accompanied by certificates, shall be given in the form of National savings certificates to holders of the first three positions in each of the examinations, who are bonafied students under Mizoram Board of School Education, on the results examinations held at the close of Primary, Middle and High School stages and Diploma in Teachers' Education final examinations (Middle Section & Primary Section) of Teachers' Training Institute.

Number and value of the Award/Prizes. 5. The numbers and value of these Awards/Prizes shall be as indicated below for the different categories.

Eligibility
and condi-
tion

6. (i) Only the children/wards of the bonafide permanent residents of Mizoram taking regular education in any Institution in Mizoram, shall be eligible for these Awards/Prizes, subject to the condition that students who fail to take the examination, for any reason whatsoever, at one chance shall not be considered for these Awards/Prizes.
- (ii) No student found guilty of misconduct and/or breach of discipline shall be eligible for these Awards/Prizes.

7. On the results of the examinations and within the stipulations contained in these regulations, the President shall announce the names of the winners of these Awards/Prizes and the Secretary shall arrange for award of these Awards/Prizes.

8. These Awards/Prizes accompanied by Certificates shall be distributed to eligible Awardees within a period not later than one year from the date of publication of the concerned Examination results at a special function specially arranged for the purpose and on the date to be appointed by the President.

9. If any question arise relating to the interpretation of these regulations, it shall be referred to the Board and the decision of the Board thereon shall be final.
