### NOTIFICATION

No.G. 12011/3/87-F.Est, the 1st February, 1989. The undersigned is directed to refer to Para XXXI of Scheduled 'A' to Government notification No.G. 12011/3/87/F.Est dated 19.12.1988 which laid down procedure for fixation of initial pay for employees holding posts specified in the notification, the pay scales of which are revised.

The procedure have been reviewed and the Governor of Mizoram, in exercise of powers conferred under proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, is pleased to amend the said para and it has now been decided that the initial pay of employees shall be fixed in the revised scales with reference to pay scales of 1973 as laid down in the Government of India's Notification No. F. 15 (1)IC/86 dated 13.9.1986 in statement prescribed and incorporated at pages 44-45 of the Central Civil Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 1986. However, no Government employees shall be eligible for payment of arrear or no employees shall be liable to recovery on account of fixation of pay in the revised pay scales during the period from 1.1.1986 to 31.12.1988. Increments will be regulated as laid down by the Central Civil Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 1986 notionally and the pay thus arrived at will be drawn from 1.1.1989 onwards.

(1) The initial pay statement shall replace the earlier initial pay statement 1986. Two copies of the new initial pay statements should be sent to Directorate of Accounts & Treasuries with service books for scrutiny and approval.

(2) Though there are changes in classification of posts in respect of some of the employees, the duties and responsibilities attached to the posts remain the same. Therefore the benefit as a result of change in status laid down in Government of India, Ministry of Finance O.M.No. 1(40)-E. XXXI(A)/65 dated 6.11.1965 incorporated in Govt. of India's order No. (4) below F.R. 23 (Swamy's compilation of FR & SR Eighth Edition) shall not be admissible.

(3) Claims for TA/DA in respect of the period from 1.1.1986 to 31.12.1988 which have been finally settle prior to the issue of this notification shall not be re-opened.

(4) Instructions regarding payment of pensions and other retirement benefits in respect of persons who retired during the period from 1.1.1986 to 31.12.1988 will be issued seperately.

### ILLUSTRATIONS

i) Initial pay of Government employees who was drawing a basic pay of Rs. 580/- in the scale of Rs. 425-700/- shall be fixed in the revised pay scale of Rs. 1640-2900/- as follow :-

a) Basic Pay	— Rs. 580.00
b) Dearness Pay, ADA, Adhoc DA, etc.	— Rs. 872.90
c) Interim Relief	— Rs. 118.00
Total (a) to (c)	— Rs. 1570.00
d) 20% of basic Pay subject to minimum of Rs. 75.	— Rs. 116.00

Total : — Rs. 1686.90

In the earlier pay scale of Rs. 1400-2300/- the initial pay of the employees was fixed on 1.1.1986 at Rs. 1720/- which was the stage next above in the scale. But in the new pay scale of Rs. 1640-2900/-, the initial pay of the employee is to be fixed at Rs. 1700/- on 1.1.1986 regulating the increments notionally as shown below :-

	1.5.1987	=	Rs. 1820/-
	1.5.1988	=	Rs. 1880/-
	1.1.1989	=	Rs. 1880/-
Pay to be drawn on DNI	1.3.1989	=	Rs. 1940/-

In the above case, there will be no recovery.
