NOTIFICATION

No. CDC-L. 10/88-89/143, the 31st March, 1989. In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 124 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), I, Shri Punya Chakma, Chairman of the Chakma District Council hereby make the following rules to regulate the composition and functions of the Business Advisory Committee of the Chakma District Council.

R U L E S

1. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :-
 - (a) "Chairman of the Committee" means the Chairman of the Business Advisory Committee of the Chakma District Council.
 - (b) "Chairman of the Council" means the Chairman of the Chakma District Council.
 - (c) "Committee" means the Business Advisory Committee of the Chakma District Council constituted under rule 2.
 - (d) "Council" means the Chakma District Council.
2. There shall be a committee called the Business Advisory Committee of which shall consist of 5 (five) members of the council to be nominated by the Chairman of the Council.
3. No member shall be appointed to the Committee if he is not willing to serve on it.
4. The Chairman of the Committee shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Council from amongst the members of the Committee.
5. Provided that if the Deputy Chairman of the Council is a member of the Committee, he shall be the Chairman of the Committee.
6. If the Chairman of the Committee is absent from any meeting for any reason or unable to act, the Chairman of the Council may appoint any of the members of the Committee to act as Chairman of the particular meeting.

7. A member desiring to resign his seat from the Committee may by writing under his hand submit such resignation addressed to the Chairman of the Council.
8. The quorum to constitute a meeting of the Committee shall be one third of the total number of members of the Committee.
9. The sittings of the Committee shall be held within the precincts of the Chakma District Council House and if necessity arises to change the place of sitting to outside the Council House, the matter shall be referred to the Chairman of the Council whose decision shall be final.
10. The sittings of the Committee shall be held on such dates and at such hours as the Chairman of the Committee may be fixed.
11. The Secretary to the Council shall be Secretary to the Committee, but the Secretary shall not be a member of the Committee.
12. The term of office of all members of the Committee shall be for a period of one year from the date of constituting the committee.
13. The Chairman of the Council may refer any resolution of which notice has been given by a member under rule 96 of the said rules to the committee for scrutiny. The Committee shall scrutinise every resolution so referred to it and make its recommendation to the Chairman of the Council regarding its admissibility under the said rules. The Committee may also suggest such amendments as it may consider necessary to make the resolution clear, precise and in conformity with the said rules.
14. (a) It shall be the function of the Committee to recommend the time that should be allocated for the discussion of the stage or stage of such Bills and other business as the Chairman of the Council, direct for being referred to the Committee.
(b) The Committee shall have the power to indicate in the proposed timetable the different hours at which the various stages of the Bill or other business shall be completed.
(c) The Committee shall have such other functions as may be assigned to by the Chairman of the Council from time to time.
15. The decision of the Committee shall be properly recorded and presented to the Chairman of the Council at least 7 (seven) days before the opening day of each session and such decisions shall also be circulated to the all members of the Committee.
16. The recommendation of the Committee on the resolutions referred to it and the time table in regard to business as settled by the Committee shall be reported by the Chairman of the Council to the House and circulated to all the members.
