No. LJD.48/87/, the 1st April, 1989. The following Act-of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, which received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Act No. 3 of 1989

The Mizoram Salaries and Allowances of the Ministers (Amendment) Act, 1989.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 30th March, 1989.

AN

ACT -

to amend the salaries and allowances of the Chief Minister and other Ministers of Mizoram.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Mizoram in the Fortieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- Short title 1. (1) This Act may be called the Mizoram Salaries and Allowances and of the Ministers (Amendment) Act, 1989. commencement.
 - (2) It shall come into force with effect from the date of its publication in the official Gazette of Mizoram.
- Amendment 2. In the Mizoram Salaries and Allowances of the Ministers Act, of section 1987 (Act No. 5 of 1987) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 3,—
 - (a) for the words "three thousand two hundred fifty rupees", the words "three thousand rupees" shall be substituted;

- (b) for the words "two thousand five hundred fifty rupees," the words "two thousand three hundred rupees" shall be substituted.
- (c) for the words "two thousand two hundred fifty rupees" the words "two thousand rupees" shall be substituted.
- Amendment 3. In the principal Act, in section 4, for the words "sumptuary of section allowances of one thousand five hundred rupees" the words "sumptuary allowances of one thousand two hundred fifty rupees" shall be substituted.
- Amendment 4. In the principal Act, in section 5, for the words "he shall be entiof section titled to a residence for which rental charges shall not be more than
 six thousand rupees per mensem". the words "he shall be entitled
 to a residence for which rental charges shall be at a flat rate of
 five thousand rupees per monsem" shall be substituted.
