The Mizoram Act No. 2 of 1989

The Mizoram Salaries, Allowances and Pension of Members of the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram (Amendment) Act, 1989.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 30th March, 1989.

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ACT

further to amend the salaties, allowances and pension of members of the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Mizoram in the Fortieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- Short title 1. and commencement
- (1) This Act may be called the Mizoram Salaries, Allowances and Pension of Members of the Legislative Assembly (Amendment) Act, 1989.
- (2) It shall come into force with effect from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
- Amendment 2. In the Mizoram Salaries, Allowances and Pension of Members of section of the Legislative Assembly Act, 1987 (Act No. 6 of 1987) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 2, in

sub-clause (ii) of clause (g), for the words "but includes the Chief Minister, the Speaker, the Ministers, the Minister of State and the Deputy Speaker for the purposes of Pension including Family pension only under section 14", the words "but includes the Chief Minister, the Speaker, the Ministers, the Ministers of State and the Deputy Speaker for the purposes of Pension under section 14 and of Death Gratuity under new section 14A" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section

- 3. In the principal Act, for the section 4, the following section shall be substituted, namely:-
- Read Constituency allowance
- 4. A member shall be paid constituency allowance of Rs. 1,000/per mensem and he shall be entitled to Contingency Allowance
 of Rs. 1,000/- per mensem."
- Amendment 4. In the principal Act, for the section 11, the following section of Section 11. shall be substituted, namely:

"Other facilities.

- 11. A member shall be entitled to the following facilities, namely:—
- (a) WATER— Every member shall be entitled to re-imbursement of monthly water charges.
- (b) ELECTRICITY— Every member shall be entitled to reimbursement of electricity charges of 300 units per month.
- (c) TELEPHONE— Every member shall be entitled to the use of a telephone as follows—
- (i) Every member is entitled to local calls free of charge on telephone installed in the Member's Hostel.
- (ii) Every member shall be entitled to have a telephone installed at Government expense at the place where he ordinarily resides or at any of the place in the State wich is also used by him for residence. The amount of initial deposit, installation and rental charges shall be borne by Government.
- (iii) In the case of a member already having a telephone, the rental charges shall be bone by Government.
- (iv) Every member shall be entitled to re-imbursement of local call charges with a maximum of 5,000 local calls every quarter of a year:

Provided that a member may re-imburse trunk call charges within the said limit of 5,000 calls"

Insertion of 5. new section 13 A.

In the principal Act, after section 13, the following section shall be inserted, namely :-

"Residence, conveyance etc. of the Government Chief Whip.

- 13A. (1) In addition to his entitlement as a member, the Government Chief Whip, if he is not a Minister, shall, with effect from the date on which he may enter upon his office, subject to rule, if any, made in this behalf, during the pe riod he continues to be such whip, and for a period of fifteen days immediately thereafter, be entitled to use of-
- (a) a furnished residence in Aizawl without payment of rent, and
- (b) a motor vehicle without payment of hire or other charges, and no charges shall fall on him in respect of the maintenance of such residence or vehicle; and so long as such residence is not provided, he shall be entitled to a residence for which rental charges shall be at a flat rate of two thousand five hundred rupees per mensem.

EXPLANATION:

- (a) 'Government Chief Whip' means that member of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly who is Government Chief Whip for the time being in that Assembly of the party in Government having the greatest numerical strength in that Assembly; and
- (b) 'maintenance' in relation to house includes the provision of electricity and water.
- (2) The Government Chief Whip shall be entitled one grade IV staff at his residence".

of section 14.

Amendment 6. In the principal Act, in section 14, in sub-section (2), for the words "one thousand rupees", the words "one thousand five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

new section 14A.

Insertion of 7. In the principal Act, in section 14 for the clause "Family pension", the following section shall be substituted, namely:—

"Death Gratuity

14A. If a member unfortunately dies during his/her term of office, his/her spouse or having no spouse living, his/her children shall be paid a death gratuity a sum of fifty thousand rupees at a time".
