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NOTIFICATION

No.F. 20020/1/83-TOUR, the 19th May, 1989. Whereas the Government of Mizoram is of the opinion that it is necessary to make rules for allotment of seats and granting of stipend to the students intending to take up Diploma Course in Hotel/ Travel Management as one year course in Foodcraft etc. in the Government recognised institution in India.

Now therefore the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules, namely :-

- Short title extent and commencement. 1 (a) These rules may be called the Mizoram allotment of seats and grant of stipend (Hotel Management, Travel Management and Foodcraft training) Rules 1989.
- (b) It shall come into force with effect from such date as the Government may by notification in the official Gazette appoint.
- Definition. 2. In these rules unless the context other wise requires ; -
- (a) "Bond" means an Agreement Bond to be executed by a student in accordance with the provision of rules 9 of these Rules;
- (b) "Department" means the Tourism Department of the Government of Mizoram.
- (c) "Director" means the Director of Tourism.
- (d) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram.
- (e) "Governor" means the Governor of Mizoram.

- (f) "Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe" means the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe as defined in the Constitution of India.

Scope. 3. Allocation of seats shall be made by the department which is empowered to fix the number of students to be sponsored for each category for a particular year and the stipend shall be granted to students permanently residing in Mizoram.

Condition of eligibility. 4. (a) Eligibility for seats and stipend for prosecution of studies in Hotel Management/Travel Management and Foodcraft Training shall depend on fulfilment of the terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Governor from time to time.

(b) A stipend holder under these rules shall not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded a merit scholarship or any other scholarship/stipend the student may exercise his/her option for either of those two scholarship/stipend whichever is beneficial to him/her and shall inform the Government through the Head of the Institution the option so made. No stipend shall be paid to the student under these Rules from the date he/she accepts another scholarship/stipend. A student may, however be paid grant or monetary help from the Government for the purchase of book or Equipment in addition to the stipend paid under these Rules.

(c) The stipend shall be payable subject to the satisfactory progress and conduct of the student. If it is reported by the Head of Institution at any time that a student has, by reasons of his/her own act or default failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance within permission of the authorities concerned etc. the Governor may stop or with-held further payment of the stipend for such period as it may think fits.

(d) If a candidate is found to have obtained a stipend by false statements, his/her stipend will be cancelled forthwith and the amount paid will be recovered at the discretion of the Governor.

(e) A stipend may be stopped if the stipend holder changes the subjects of the course of study for which the stipend was originally granted or changes the Institution of study without the prior approval of the Governor. The Head of

the Institution shall report of such cases to the Government and stop payment of the stipend amount. The amount paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the Governor.

Application for admission and Stipend

7. Application for admission to the Institution for studies shall be invited by the Director from the intending students by advertisement giving reasonable time prior to the commencement of academic sessions as may be deemed suitable and proper in the form of application as may be prescribed, with other necessary particulars.

Scrutiny by the Selection Board.

6. (a) On expiry of the last date of submission of applications by the students for allocation of seats and for stipend, the Director shall prepare a statement of all applications with detailed particulars in terms of advertisement and shall forward the statement so prepared alongwith such application received to the Secretary to the Government of Mizoram of the Department concerned within the time limit as may be fixed by the Department.

(b) On receipt of applications from the Director as stated in clause (a) the Secretary to the Government of Mizoram shall convene a meeting of the Selection Board to be constituted by the Governor with the following members for scrutiny and final allocation of seats reserved by Government of India from time to time under different Institutions for Scheduled Caste or Schedule Tribe and in accordance with the criteria laid down by the Government of India, grant stipend to the deserving students subject to the availability of fund :—

- (i) Secretary to the Government of Mizoram of the concerned Deptt. Chairman.
- (ii) Secretary to the Government of Mizoram Finance Department or his representative Member.
- (iii) The Director of Tourism—Member—Secretary.

Award of Stipend

7. The Government of Mizoram may give all or any selected students a monthly stipend as prescribed below and an annual Book Grant as specified, subject to revision of the rates of the stipend and the grants from time to time by the Governor as may be considered necessary.

The Book Grant indicated above shall be restricted to the actual cost of the Text Books purchased or the amount indicated above whichever is less. An excess amount shall be adjusted with the similar grant of the next year.

Duration of Stipend.

8. (a) The grant of stipend once made will be tenable for the State at which it is given to the completion of the course subject to good conduct and regularity in attendance.
- (b) Stipend may be renewed from year to year.
- (c) If a student fails in the examination for the first time in the entire course of study, he may be given another chance by renewing the stipend but not Book Grant, provided the student is required to attend the the class as a regular student and the Governor is satisfied that the reason for such failure is not due to negligence and carelessness on the part of the student, and that would be treated as a renewal case.
- (d) If a student is unable to appear in annual examination owing to illness; the award may be renewed for the next academic Year on submission of the Medical Certificate to the satisfaction of the Head of Institution and on his certifying that the student would have passed had he appeared in the the examination and his attendance was satisfaction throughout the year.

(e) The selected candidates may be given travelling allowances entitled to Category Government Servant on tour for initial joining the institution and also for return journey on completion of the whole course.

**Execution
of Bond.**

9. Student selected for stipend shall execute a bond in prescribed form appended hereto at Appendix 'A'. On successful completion of the Course for which Government of Mizoram for a minimum period of 5 years. In case the student leaves the College/Institution before passing the final course without the permission of the Governor for any reason whatsoever including illness, discharge or dismissal for misconduct or after having entered in the Government service if he/she refuses to serve the period specified in the Bond shall be liable to refund all sums paid to him/her by the Governor while in studies with five percent per annum interest thereon.

Payment

10. (a) The stipend to the students shall be payable from the month of his/her joining the course of study to the month in which the final examination is completed.
- (b) The stipend shall, be payable to students studying courses including summer/winter vacation falling in their course of study.
- (c) The amount of stipend due in respect of the student shall be paid through the Head of the Institutions.
- (d) If it is reported by the Head of the concerned institution that a Scholar is without text book, stationery etc. the value of the Book Grant may be reduced at the discretion of the authority sanctioning the stipend.
- (e) In addition to the stipend and Book Grant, the students shall be paid the expenditure for excursions and study tours organised by the College/Institutions at the rate of actual fare for road and rail journey provided that the expenditure is certified by respective college Institution authorities. Excursion will include field trainings.
- (f) In the case of the death of the student the amount of stipends due to him/her upto the end of the month the student has attended the Institution shall be paid to, the parents Guardians/Legal heir of the student through the Head of Institution.

Whereas the candidate has on his application, been selected for nomination against a seat reserved for a Government of Mizoram nominee, to undergo training for the
(herein after referred to as the said college/Institute).

And whereas the candidate has, in consideration of his nomination, agreed to complete the training for the said course at the said College/Institute subject to the condition herein after appearing;

Now, therefore, this agreement witnesseth and it is hereby agreed as follows :—

1. The candidate shall diligently complete his training for the said course at the said College/Institute, shall abide by the rules of the said College/Institute for the time being in force regulating the conduct of students at the said College/Institute and shall pass all the examination prescribed for the said course, by the University or the Board of Technical Education.

2. Failing to, qualify in any year or years, the candidate in that case, may continue his study at his own cost for the year or years, so lost during which year or years the Government of Mizoram will not be bound to grant any stipend etc.; as aforesaid to him, but the Government may pay stipends etc. to him for any such years lost.

3. Upon passing the final Examinations, the candidate shall serve as Receptionist/Tourist Guide or Assistant Receptionist for a period of at least five years under the Government of Mizoram. However, the Government reserve the right not to appoint any or all the candidates on passing the training if there is no vacant post. Candidates not appointed under the Government shall however, have to obtain a no objection certificate from the Government for accepting any other employment outside Government Departments.

4. While in service under clause 3, the pay and allowances and other conditions of service of the candidate shall be regulated by the rules and orders of the Government for the time being in force for the post to which he is appointed.

5. If the candidate leaves the College/Institute before passing the final examination without the previous permission of the Government in writing for any reason whatever including illness or if he is discharged or dismissed for misconduct or if he refuses to serve in accordance with clause 3 or resigned or is dismissed for misconduct from such service, before completion of..... years of services, then in any such event, he shall have to pay the Governor on demand and without a demur all money paid to the Candidate and other expenses incurred on his account along with interest of five percent per annum till the date of repayment in connection with undergoing training as the Government of Mizoram may direct. The decision of the Government of Mizoram under this clause, as to commission of a breach, as also the amount of compensation payable in respect thereof shall be final and binding on the Candidate.

6. Any sum falling due from the candidate under this agreement may be recovered from him as an arrear of land revenue.

7. If any dispute shall arise between the parties hereto in respect of this agreement, or any of the provisions herein contained or anything arising hereof the decision of Governor shall be final and binding.
