NOTIFICATION

No. 464/89 (1) :— Whereas the President of India has, by notification published in the Gazette of India on the 23rd October, 1989, called upon all parliamentary constituencies (other than those in the State of Assam) to elect members to the House of the People;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India hereby appoints with respect to the State of Mizoram.

- (a) the 30th October, 1989 (Monday) as the last date for making nominations,
- (b) the 31st October, 1989 (Tuesday) as the date for scrutiny of nominations,
- (c) the 2nd November, 1989 (Thursday) as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures,
- (d) from the parliamentary constituency specified in column 1 of the Schedule below, the date or dates specified against the said parliamentary constituency in column 2 thereof as the date or dates on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken in that constituency or in the area comprised within the assembly constituency specified in column 3 against each of the dates; and
- (e) the 4th December, 1989 (Monday) as the date before which the election shall be completed.
