NOTIFICATION

NO. B. 13016/8/88-EDN, the 8th December, 1989. Whereas the Government has found that the facilities of free tuition under the Mizoram Aided Schools Fee Compensation Grants Rules, 1989 could not extended to the Aided Middle Schools in Mizoram as there is no provision in the relevant portion of the said Rules;

And whereas the Government deems it expedient to extend similar facilities of free tuition to deserving pupils of Aided Middle Schools, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules, to amend the Amended Mizoram Aided Schools Fee Compensation Grants Rules, 1989, namely:—

Short title and commencement: 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Aided Schools Fee Compensation Grants (Amendment) Rules, 1989.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of 2. For the short title, "The Amended Mizoram Aided Schools short title:

Fees Compensation Grants Rules, 1989, the short title "The Mizoram Aided Schools Fees Compensation Grants Rules, 1989" shall be substituted.

Amendment 3. In the Mizoram Aided Schools Fees Compensation Grants Rules of Rule 5: 1989, as amended for Rule 5, the following Rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"Rate of tui- 5. Subject to the provision of Rule 6, the rate of tuition fees for tion Fees: Aided Schools may be fixed as follows:—

(i) Class V (ii) Classes VI & VII (iii) Class VIII

(iv) Classes IX & X

Rs. 5.00 per month Rs. 7.00 per month Rs. 10.00 per month
