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NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/78/80-APT(B), the 21st November, 1989. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post (s) of Checker under Taxation Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short title & commencement: (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Taxation Department (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1989.
(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application: 2. The rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in Col I of the Annexure--I hereto annexed.
3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay: The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure I aforesaid.
4. Method of rectt., age limit and other qualifications: The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belong to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification : No person,
 a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination :
 6 (A) Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
 Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in Schedule/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

7. Power to relax : Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

8. Reservation, other concessions : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.,

9. Repeal and Saving: All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt.21.1.1972, are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

basin (refer map enclosed) the land is hilly with slopes varying from 5% to 25% and Land capacity classification of III and IV. According to Agriculture Department the Lands are very fit for terrace cultivation of paddy, Sugarcane etc. and horticultural crops like bananas, orange and various other fruits etc. According to the norms of the Government of Mizoram for Jhum Control Programme, land of 2 Ha area is given to each family of a village to change over from Jhum cultivation like terrace farming and horticulture. But for the rehabilitation of the village of Builum, it is proposed to allot to each family, an area of 4 Ha each of non-forest land so that they may resettle comfortably in their new location. The areas proposed for rehabilitation are Revenue Department land and will be available free of cost.

The detailed schemes of the financial implications as included in the Project estimate, is as shown in the annexure enclosed.
