NOTIFICATION

No. STV. 6(1)/80/Pt, the 26th March, 1990. In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (iii) of Rule 108 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 the Government of Mizoram is pleased to allow display of Red Lights on top of Government Vehicles to the following dignitaries/officials only with immediate effect:-

1. Governor
2. Chief Minister
3. Cabinet Ministers/Speaker/Ministers of State/Deputy Speaker/Deputy Minister
4. Vice Chairman, State Planning Board.
5. Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary/Commissioners.
6. All Secretaries to the Government of Mizoram.
7. District Magistrates
8. Inspector General of Police
9. D.I.G.Ps
10. S.Ps in charge of districts.
11. Pilot Vehicles of V.I.Ps.

2. When the V.I Ps are not travelling the Vehicles fitted with redlights, it should be ensured that the redlights are properly covered.

3) Red Lights of 22.5. sq cms size should be used and Red Lights of 60 sq cms which are already in use in some Vehicles should be replaced by 22.5 sq cms in size.

4. This supersedes all previous order on this subject.
