## NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/24/80-APT(B), the 22nd May, 1990. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post (s) of Private Secretary to the Government of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. (i) These rules may be called, the Mizoram Stenographer Grade -I (Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1990.  
(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. The rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in Col. 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
3. Numbers of posts classification and scale of pays. The number of the said posts, their classification and the Scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure-I aforesaid.
4. Method of rectt. age limit and other qualification. The age limit qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Said Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for directt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification : No person,
- a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.
  - b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.
- Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing, so exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination : Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

6 (A) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in Schedule/Annexure to these rules to any other post of position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

7. Power to relax : Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

8. Reservation, other concessions : Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

9. Repeal and Saving: All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt.21.1.1972 and Govt. of Mizoram Notification No.ABR.55/77/53-56 dt. 30. 8. 1979 No.A.12018/24/80-APT (B) dt. 11.12.1981 & No. A. 12018 24/80-APT(B) dt. 28.9.1988. are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

namely :—

1. Short title and Commencement :
  - i) These rules may be called the Mizoram Stenographer Grade-II (Group 'B' posts) and Grade-III (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment (Third Amendment) Rules, 1990
  - ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. In the Mizoram Stenographer Grade-II & III (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment (Second Amendment) Rules, 1985 the existing provisions under col. II in respect of Stenographer Grade-II, shall be substituted by proviso :

“Promotion : from working Stenographer Grade-III who passed speed test in short hand at 100 wpm with not less than 2 years regular service in the grade”
