Sept., 1972—Whereas the Administrator Mizoram, after careful consideration of all facts and circumstances, is of the opinion that the whole area of the Union Territory of Mizoram is in such disturbed and dangerous condition that use of Armed Forces in aid of Civil Power is necessary.

Now, therefore, in exercise of t e powers conferred by section 3 of the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958, the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare the whole of Mizoram as disturbed area within the meaning and for the purpose of the said Act for a period of six months.
