THE PUNJAB APPROPRIATION (No. 2) BILL, 1990

ANACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab for the services of the financial vear 1990-91.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Punjab Appro-Short title. priation (No. 2) Act, 1990
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab there may be paid and 5461,91,01,000 applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate finclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Punjab Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1990] to the sum of five thousand four hundred and sixtyone crore, ninety-one lakh and one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1990-91 in restpect of the services specified in column 2 of the schedule.
