No. H. 12018/17/91-LJD, the 27th March 1991. The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Act No. 9 of 1991
The Mizoram Appropriation (No.5) Act, 1991.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 27th March, 1991)

AN ACT

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on 31st day of March, 1984, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty second year of the Republic of India as follows:
