(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 27th March, 1991)

AN ACT

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on 31st day of March, 1985, in excess of the amount granted for those services and for that year.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty second Year of the Republic of India as follows :

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 6) Act, 1991.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Act amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one crore thirty four lakh thirty seven thousand and six hundred ninety nine rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet for the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the

The sums deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory/State Government of Mizoram under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1985.
