AN ACT

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on 31st day of March, 1985, in excess of the amount granted for those services and for that year.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty second Year of the kepublic of india as follows:

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 6) Act, 1991.
