No. H. 12018/20/91-LJD, the 27th March, 1991. The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1991.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 27th March, 1991)

## AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the service of the financial Year 1991-92.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty second year of Republic of India as follows:

- Short title : 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1991.
- Issue of Rs. 4,37,04,60,000.00 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the financial year 1991-92. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of four hundred thirty seven crores and four lakhs, sixty thousands towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1991-92 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- Appropriation : 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
