## ORDER

GSR: In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following order to amend the Non-Pressure Stove (Quality Control) Order, 1990, namely:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be called the Non-Pressure Stoves (Quality Control) (Amendment) Order, 1991.
  - (2) It shall come into force on the 1st day of Feb/92.

- 2. In the Non-Pressure Stoves (Quality Control) Order, 1990:
  - (i) In clause 1, for sub-clause (3), the following sub-clause shall be substructed, namely:
    - "(3) It shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1992.";
  - (ii) in clause 2, for sub-clause (b), the following sub-clause shall be sub-mitted, namely "(b)" specified standard "means the Indian Standard Specification No. IS:2980 1986 specified for non pressure stoves".
  - (iii) in clause 5, for sub-clause (1), the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely:
    - "(1). Any Officer of the State Government, not below the rank of an Inspector, in the Food and Civil Supplies Department or in any other department, duly authorised by a notification published in the official gazette by such State Government may, with a view to carry out the provisions of this Order, or for the purpose of satisfying himself that this Order or any order made thereunder has been complied with,
  - (a) enter any search any place, premises of factory which the Officer has reason to believe, has been, or is being or is about to be, used for the contravention of this order;
  - (b) seize stocks of non-pressure stoves, raw materials or components which the officer has reason to believe has been, or is being or is about to be, used in contravention of this Order".
