NOTIFICATION

No.A. 34012/1/89-PERS (B), the 14th April, 1991. In exercise, of the powers conferred under the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the provisions of Rules 10 and 19 of Mizoram Civil Service Rules, 1988 the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following regulations namely :-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT -

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Mizoram Civil Service (Departmental Examination) Regulations, 1991
- (2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in official Gazette.
- 2. DEFINITIONS (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Aizoram Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Mizoram Jublic Service Commission;
 - (c) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram;
 - (d) "Governor' means the Governor of Mizoram.

(2) All other words and expressions used in these Regulations and not defined shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Mizoram Civil Service Rules, 1988 as amended from time to time.

3. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION -

¢

(1) Every probationer who is in Junior Grade of Mizoram. Civil Service shall, during the period of probation, appear at a Departmental Examination and shall be required to pass the minimum standard prescribed under rule 5 before they are considered for promotion to the next higher grade.

4.

- (2) The Examination shall be conducted by the Commission/Government in the manner as laid down in these regulations.
- (3) The exact date on which the examination shall be held shall fixed by the Commission/Government.

SYLLABI FOR DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION -WRITTEN EXAMINATION :

There shall be five papers each consisting of son e subjects for the - examination and the total marks being 450 allotted to each of the subjects as follows, namely :-

- MINIMUM MARKS : Candidates shall be required to obtain 33 marks in a single paper with 45 percent in the total aggregate at the written examination or as may be determined by the Commission/Government.

POWER OF GOVERNOR TO EXEMPT - Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions, the Governor of Mizoran may exempt by general or special order any officer governed by the Mizoram Civil Service Rules, 1988 as amended from time to time from the requirement of passing the departmental examination in the interest of Public service if in the opinion of the Governor such insistence on passing of the said examination will impose undue hardship and disadvantage to such officer.

REPEALS AND SAVING :--

- (1) The Mizoram Civil Service (Departmental Examination) Regulation, 1990 notified in the official Gazette on the 23rd January, 1990 is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken or purported to be taken under the said rules so repealed shall be taken as done or purported to be done under these Rules.
