### THE MIZORAM SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF THE MINISTERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1991.

#### AN

#### ACT

further to amend the salaries and allowances of the Chief Minister and other Ministers of Mizoram.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Mizoram in the Forty-Second year of the Republic of India, as follows :--

commencement

- Short title and 1. (1) This Act may be called the Mizoram Salaries and Allowances of the Ministers (Amendment) Act, 1991.
  - (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the First of April, 1991.

Amendment of section 3

In the Mizoram Salaries and A'lowances of the Ministers 2. Act, 1987 (Act No. 5 of 1987), as amended (here-nafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 3.—

.2 . . .

- (a) for the words "each Minister, a salary of two thousand three hundred rupees per mensem", the words "each Minister, a salary of two thousand five hunred rupees per mensem" shall be substituted:
- (b) for the words "each Minister of State, a salary of two thousand rupees per mensem", the words "each Minister of State, a salary of two thousand two hundred fifty rupees per mensem" shall be substituted.

In the principal Act, in section 4, for the words "sumptuary Amendment 3. allowance of one thousand two hundred fifty rupees each per mensem, of section 4 family allowance of three hundred rupees each per mensem and entertaiment allowance of seven hundred rupees each per mensem," the words "Sumptuary allowance of two thousand seven hund red fifty tupees each per mensem, family allowance of two thousand rupees each per mensem and entertainment allowance of one thousand rupees each per mensem" shall be substituted.

4. In the principal Act, in section 5, for the words "rental charges shall not be more than five thousand rupees per mensem", the words "rental charges shall not be more than six thousand rupees per mensem" shall be substituted.

5. In the principal Act, after section 6, the following new section Insertion of new section 6A shall be inserted, namely :---

"Free 6A Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act and subject to the provisions of the Schedule, a Minister shall be entitled to free tra-Travelling velling by First Class train upto 20,000 kilometres or by Air two by Train or by Air with times in five years' term within India, with family upto 5 members. members of family.

Amendment 6. In the principal Act, in the schedule,-

of the schedule (i) in clause 1, for the words "daily allowance at the maximum rates applicable to first grade officer of the Goverment of Mizoram" the words "daily allowance at the rate of Rs.175/- per day (No separate sitting and daily allowance)" shall be substituted;

(ii) in clause 2, for the words "travelling allowance on the maximum rates for the time being admissible to Ist grade officers of the Government of Mizorum", the words "travelling allowance at the rate of Rs. 175/- per day" shall be substituted. î fi .
