NOTIFICATION

No. LAD/SAN-5/91(A) the 23rd October, 1991. In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (e) of section 138 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules, namely --

Short title : 1. (1) extent and commencement

- (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram (Regulation and Control of Vehicles Parking) Rules, 1991;
 - (2) They shall extend to such town and places as the Government may by notification declare and specify in Mizoram Gazette;
 - (3) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Definition

- : 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires -
 - (a) 'Act' means the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988;
 - (b) 'Government' means the State Government of Mizoram;
 - (c) 'Motor Vehicle' means all types of motor vehicles including two wheelers;
 - (d) 'Parking areas' or 'Places of Parking' means suitable places selected by Government within the town area such as public street, any part of road sides, foot-path or any open spaces for use parking places of vehicles;
 - (c) 'Town' means the town of Aizawl or any other towns in Mizoram notified as such by the Government for implementation of these rules,
 - (f) 'Peak hours' means a period from 8:0 to 10:00 of the clock in the morning and 2;30 to 5:30 of the clock in evening.

of parking areas

- Declaration : 3. (1) The Government may declare and specify from time to time parking areas in different parts of towns as parking places for vehicle of different kinds. Such parking areas shall notified and published in local newspaper for information of general public;
 - (2) The Government may also select and declare from time to time suitable areas within the town limit as parking areas in consideration of the need of shopping centre, public office, bus stand, public convenience etc.:
 - (3) No motor vehicle shall park on any public streets, road sides, thoroughfares or any open spaces within the limit of proper town area except in particular places demarcated specifically by the Government as parking areas.
 - 1. (1) The Government or its authorised agent, may charge a parking fee on vehicle during fee parking hours for parking on such places specified as parking areas as per the rate prescribed in the T ble 'A' of the 'Schedule of these Rules. The Govenment may reduce or enhance the rate of parking fee from time to time.

Provided that the Government may by a notification demarcate Parking areas for Taxis and Public carrier Licensing vehicles and charge parking fees to be prescribed in such notification from to time;

Provided further that the Government may fix the rate of parking fee for the Government owned Truck terminal/Parking Place from time to time;

- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained sub-rule (1), no parking fee shall be charged to any vehicle belonging to the Fire Brigate, The Armed Forces, The Border Task Force, Police, Magistrate and other officers on duty;
- (3) As soon as parking fee is collected from any vehicle, the collector shall issue receipt duly approved by the Government. The receipt should specify the kind of vehicle, its registration number, time of entering into parking areas and also the agency who is making the collection;
- (4) The parking fee shall be realised through departmental employee, duly authorised for the purpose, or by any authorised agency appointed by public auction or through licences on terms and conditions as the Government may determine.

Parking of : 5. vehicle at the Parking Areas.

The vehicle shall be parked at the owner/drivers risk and responsibility. The Government shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage of the vehicles parked at the parking areas.

Collection • of parking fee

Provided that the Government shall provide security measures in the Government owned Truck Terminal/Parking place as far as possible.

No owner or driver of a motor vehicle shall stop his vehicle on the middle of the road or in any convenient place or any bind corner for embarking and disembarking of passengers and their luggages.

Provided that no parking on the road thoroughfare or any other places other than the parking places shall be allowed more than the time prescribed for loading of commodities.

Provided further, that parking of vehicles on the main roads for loading and unloading during the peak hours is prohibited under unless special permit is given by the authority.

No owner of vehicle or driver of any vehicle shall be allowed to remove his vehicle from the parking areas without payment of parking fee.

8. No vehicle whether serviceable or unserviceable, Government or private, shall be allowed to park on any parking places or any road within the proper town area more than 10 hours continuously, whether it is in the working hours or night time without prior approval of the Government. However, the government may grant permission at the risk of the owner of the vehicle for parking of vehicle at various parking places or public road sides on payment of parking fee prescribed in the table 'B' of the schedule of these rules.

Violation of any provision of these rules shall be liable to pay a fine of one hundred rupees for the first offence which may extend to one thousand rupees in case of repeated or continuous breach.

> 10. (1) If the owner or the driver of any vehicle refused to pay the fine for illegal parking, the vehicle shall be seized by the nearest Police who will issue seizure list thereof. lf situation demands such seized vehicles shall be removed to the nearest Police Station or to a place specified by the authority at the cost of the owner of the vehicle. Such vehicle can only be released on payment of additional fine of rupees two hundred and fifty which may extend to rupees five hundred;

(2) The State Police shall extend all necessary assistance to the collectors of parking fee in regulating and controlling the places of parking and all other illegal parking thereof.

Prohibition : 6. of parking of vehicles on the middle of the road.

- Prohibition : 7. of drawing out vehicles from the 2 parking areas without payment of parking fee.
- Prohibition : of parking more than ten hours without permission.

Penalty for : 9. violation of rules.

Seizure of : vehicles in case of refusal of payment.

11. Any Executive Magistrates under Government of Mizoram or any Police Officer, not below the rank of Sub-Inspector, may award fines as specified in these rules on the spot or otherwise.

2. TABLE 'B'

ROAD SIDE GARRAGING FEES (See rule 8)

Type of vehicles For permitted vehicles to park for more than 10 hours at a time on the demarcated parking areas or any of the public road sides, upper space other than private compound.

Truck, Buses, Lorry, Vans, Tractor or any other heavy vehicle.	Rs 25/- per day/night or Rs 500/- a calendar month.
One tons, Jonga.	Rs 15/- per day/night or Rs 300/- a calendar month.
Private cars, Jeeps, Taxi, Tourist Taxis.	Rs 10/- per day/night or Rs 150/- a calendar month.
Motor cycle and Scooter.	Rs 5/- per day/night or Rs 150/- a calendar month.

NOTE: Vehicle using the public road sides as garrage regularly or irregularly shall be given formal permission to park their vehicles on payment of above fee.
