In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post (s) of Supdt, of Accounts & Asstt. Superintendent of Accounts in the Food & Civil Supdies Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely:

- 1. Short title and (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram, Food & Civil commencement: SupplyDepartment (Group 'B', Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 1991.
 - (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application: The rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in Col. 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
- 3. Numbers of post, The number of the said posts, their classification and the classification scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Co-and scale of pay: lumns-2 to 4 to the Annexure-I aforesaid.
- 4. Method of rectt. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to age limit and other the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of qualification: the said Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification:

No person,

a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage

with a person having a spouse living; or b) who having a spouse living has entered into or

contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so. exempt any person from the operation of these rules. Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

Notwith standing anything contained in Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in dule/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

Governor is of the opinion that it is Where the necessary or expedient so to de, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt, or Govt, of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt, of Assam and were in force in the erswhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Gevt. of India, Ministry of Home Alfairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt. 21. 1. 1972 No. A. 12018/6/87-PAR(GS) dt. 8. 4. 1988 are hereby repealed.
