THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1992

No. 2 of 1992

Promulgated by the President in the Forty-second Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- Short title and commencement.
- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Representation of the People (Second Amendment) Ordinance 1992.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment 2. In section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, in of section clause (d), for the words "twentieth day" the words "fourteenth day" 30 of Act shall be substituted.
