RULES FOR THE GRANT OF INCENTIVES/SUBSIDIES UNDER THE INDUSTRIAL POLICY OF MIZORAM STATE, 1989.

For the purposes of granting of Industrial Incentives, and Subsidies under the Industrial Policy of the State of Mizoram, the Government of Mizoram is pleased to make rules which may be called the Mizoram Industrial Incentives and Subsidies Rules, 1991 as follows :—

1. SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT :—

- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Industrial Incentives and Subsidies Rules, 1991.
- (2) These rules shall be applicable to such industrial units as come into production, for the first time, on or after 1st April, 1989 and to such industrial units as came into production prior to 1st April, 1989 but taking up expansion, modernisation and diversification on or after 1st April, 1989 exclusive of applicability in respect of Interest Subsidy as laid down in rule 8.

(3) These rules shall come into force with immediate effect from 1st April 1989.

2. DEFINITIONS : In these rules unless the context otherwise requires —

- (a) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram.
- (b) "Secretary" means Secretary to the Government of Mizoram.
- (c) "Director of Industries" means the Director of Industries, Mizoram.
- (d) "District Industries Centre" means the District Industries Centre in Mizoram.
- (e) "District Office" means the District Industries Centre/s or any other District Office/s under the Industries Department of Mizoram.
- (f) "District Officer" means the General Manager of the District Industries Centre or any other officer nominated or designated by the Government/Director of Industries to perform the duties of the District Officer as contained in these rules.
- (g) "Plant and Machinery" means plant and machinery purchased by the unit for its production.
- (h) "Fixed Capital Investment" means actual investment made on land, building, plant and machinery by a new unit or existing unit undergoing expansion/modernisation/diversification.
- (i) "Industries Department" means Industries Department under the Government of Mizoram.
- (j) "Committee/Selection Committee" means the State Level Committee constituted by the Government of Mizoram.
- (k) "Industrial Estate" means an Industrial Estate set up in Mizoram by the Industries Department or other agency under the Government of Mizoram.
- (l) "Industrial Growth Centre" means an Industrial Growth Centre set up in Mizoram by the Industries Department or other agency under the Government of Mizoram.
- (m) "Industrial Area" means an Industrial Area set up in Mizoram and declared by the Industries Department or other agency under the Government of Mizoram.
- (n) "New Unit" means an Industrial Unit which has taken one or more effective steps on or after 1st April, 1989.
- (o) "Existing Unit" means an Industrial unit which has gone into production prior to 1st April, 1989.

- (p) "Effective Step" means one or more of the following :
- (i) 60 per cent or more of the capital issued for the industrial unit has been paid up.
 - (ii) Substantial part of the factory building has been constructed.
 - (iii) A firm order has been placed for substantial part of the plant and machinery required for the industrial unit.
- (q) "Industrial Unit" means an Industrial unit falling within the definition of large, medium, small scale or tiny units as given by the Government of India and duly registered with the Industries Department or any other prescribed competent authority.
- (r) "Large & Medium Scale Unit" means an Industrial Unit defined as such by the Government of India under the Industries (Development and Regulations) Act, 1951, duly registered with the Director General of Technical Development or any other prescribed competent authority.
- (s) "Small Scale Unit" means an industrial unit falling within the definition of such unit as given by Government of India and duly registered with the Industries Department, Mizoram.
- (t) "Tiny Unit" means an Industrial Unit falling within the definition of such unit as given by the Government of India and duly registered with the Industries Department, Mizoram.
- (u) "Ancillary Unit" means an ancillary industrial unit falling within the definition of such unit as given by the Government of India and duly registered with the Industries Department, Mizoram.
- (v) "Expansion and/or modernisation" means additional fixed capital investment of not less than 25% by a unit over and above its existing fixed capital investment resulting in at least 25% increase in the existing installed capacity.
- (w) "Diversification" means a minimum of 25% of additional fixed capital investment made by a unit over its existing fixed capital investment for starting the production of any additional item.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCENTIVES/SUBSIDIES.

- (a) The Industrial unit located and having its registered office in Mizoram is eligible for the incentives/subsidies.
- (b) New Industrial unit in the private, joint and Cooperative sector is eligible for the incentives/subsidies.
- (c) Existing industrial unit is eligible for the incentive/subsidies, for the expanded portions as a result of expansion, modernisation and diversification on or after 1st April, 1989.

4. INCENTIVES/SUBSIDIES

Subsidy on Cost of Project Report.

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION

- (i) An industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy only for the amount of cost of Project Report already paid to the concerned consultant/agency as approved/recognised by the Government of India/Director of Industries.
- (ii) An industrial unit is eligible to claim the subsidy only after taking effective steps.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

Subsidy on cost of Project Report to an Industrial unit shall be :—

- (i) 90 percent in case of tiny unit subject to a ceiling of Rs. 5,000/- per unit.
- (ii) 75 per cent in case of small scale and ancillary units and small scale service establishments subject to a ceiling of Rs. 25,000/- per unit.
- (iii) 50 per cent in case of medium and large scale units subject to a ceiling of Rs 50,000/- per unit.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of subsidy on cost of Project Report shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'A'.

5. LAND SUBSIDY.

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

An industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy on the amount of lease charge/fee on developed land allotted to the unit and on the amount spent for development of the allotted undeveloped land within the Industrial Estate, Industrial Growth Centre or Industrial Area declared by the Industries Department.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

- i) 25% of the lease charge/fee of allotted developed/undeveloped land will be subsidised for a period of five years.
- ii) 25% of the amount spent by the unit on development of undeveloped land allotted to the unit will be subsidised.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for the grant of land subsidy shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'B'.

D. SELECTION COMMITTEE

Composition of the State Level Committee shall be:-

- 1) Secretary, Industries Department — Chairman
- 2) Secretary, Finance Department or his nominee not below the rank of Deputy Secretary. — Member
- 3) General Managers, District Industries Centres. — Members
- 4) Director of Industries — Member Secretary.

6. FACTORY RENT SUBSIDY

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION

- i) The subsidy can be claimed by new tiny and small scale unit occupying the built up factory sheds within the declared Industrial Estates/Industrial Growth Centre/Industrial Area on monthly rent basis.
- (ii) The Subsidy can also be claimed by the existing tiny and small scale units on rents of built up factory sheds occupied for the expanded portion only.
- (iii) The subsidy can be claimed by the aforementioned units for a period of 5 years from the date of commercial production.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

Subsidy on Factory Rent to an Industrial unit shall be 50 percent of the duly assessed rent of Factory Shed subject to a ceiling of Rs. 30,000/- per unit per year.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of subsidy on Factory Rent shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'C'

7. MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT SUBSIDY

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- i) New and existing industrial units which have already gone into production which send their workers to Institutions or registered/licensed Industrial units outside Mizoram duly approved by the Director of Industries for training for upgradation of their skills are eligible to claim the subsidy.
- (ii) An industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy on expenditure for managerial and technical training of its workers.
- (iii) An industrial unit to claim the subsidy should give an undertaking that the trained workers will continue to be employed by it after training at least for a period of 3 years.
- (iv) An industrial unit to claim the subsidy should take prior approval of the Director of Industries before sending of its worker/s for training.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

Subsidy shall be limited to 50 per cent of the actual expenditure for training subject to a ceiling of Rs. 3000/— per trainee and Rs. 25,000/— per unit per year.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of subsidy on Manpower development shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'D'.

8. INTEREST SUBSIDY

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION

- (i) An industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy only on the amount of interest on term loan and working capital loan already paid to the concerned Banks/Financial Institutions/Agencies.
- (ii) An industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy only for the amount of interest where the repayment is made in time. No subsidy can be claimed for overdue repayment.
- (iii) An industrial unit is eligible to claim the subsidy on interest on term loan and working capital loan for 5 years from the date of commissioning of the unit.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

- (i) The interest on loan paid by an industrial unit in excess of 8 1/2 per cent shall be subsidised up to a maximum of 4 per cent.
- (ii) Subsidy shall be limited to a claim on a total amount not exceeding Rs. 3,60,000/- paid by an industrial unit towards interest on term loan in a full year. However, for working capital loan, the total amount paid towards interest on which subsidy can be claimed shall be limited to Rs. 1,20,000/- in a full year.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of interest subsidy shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'E'.

9. POWER SUBSIDY

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- i) Subsidy is eligible for charges on power consumed for industrial production. A separate energy meter should be installed for the industrial purpose.
- ii) The industrial unit should have power supply connection from authorised Department/agency.
- iii) No subsidy is eligible for power consumed for domestic lighting and other purposes.
- iv) The subsidy can be claimed by an industrial unit for 5 years from the date of commissioning of the unit.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

- i) 60 per cent of total expenditure on power consumption in case of tiny, small scale and ancillary units.
- ii) 50 per cent of the total expenditure on power consumption in case of medium scale unit.
- iii) 30 per cent of the total expenditure on power consumption in case of large scale unit.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of Power Subsidy shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'F'.

10. SUBSIDY ON POWERLINE

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

An Industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy on cost of drawal of power lines from the main power lines to the site of the Industrial unit/factory shed which is executed by approved Department/agency.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

Subsidy on costs of drawal of powerlines to an Industrial unit shall be limited to 50 per cent of the actual expenditure subject to a ceiling of Rs. 50,000/- per unit.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM

Application for grant of subsidy on costs of drawal of powerlines shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'C'.

11. SUBSIDY ON POWER GENERATING SET

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION

- i) An Industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy on the cost of captive generating set and installation charge thereof actually used for industrial purpose.
- ii) The captive generating set for which subsidy claimed should be brand new and purchased directly from the manufactures or its regional/local agent.
- iii) In the case of second hand generating set, the cost of the generating set shall be calculated on the basis of the life of the generating set and the exact depreciated value.
- iv) The installation of the generating set, on whose charge the subsidy to be claimed should be executed by the supplier of the generating set or its regional/local agent or other approved agency.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY

Subsidy on cost and installation charge of captive generating set to an industrial unit shall be limited to 50 percent of the cost of generating set and installation charge thereof subject to a ceiling of Rs. 3,00,000/- per unit.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM.

Application for grant of subsidy on cost of generating set shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'H'

12. STATE TRANSPORT SUBSIDY ON PLANT & MACHINERIES.

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS.

- i) A new industrial unit is eligible to claim the subsidy on actual cost of transportation of plants and machineries from place of purchase to location of the unit.
- ii) An existing industrial unit is eligible to claim subsidy on actual cost of transportation of plants and machineries for the expanded portion only from place of purchase to location of the unit.
- iii) For movement of plants and machineries from outside the state actual cost of transportation by railway or on road or both from place of purchase to location of the industrial unit is eligible for the subsidy.
- iv) For movement of plants and machineries within the state, actual cost of transportation on road from the godown of the approved supplier/regional or local agent of the manufacturer/supplier of the plants and machineries to location of the industrial unit is eligible for the subsidy.
- v) For the cost of transportation on road, the cost of transportation charged by the road transport agency approved by the Director of Industries or the rate of transportation approved by the Director of Industries will be eligible.

B. LIMIT OF SUBSIDY.

Subsidy on cost of transportation of plants and machineries shall be 50 per cent of the actual cost of transportation by railway or on road or both.

C. APPLICATION FOR CLAIM.

Application for grant of State Transport Subsidy on plant and machineries shall be submitted in duplicate to the concerned District Office in the prescribed form under Appendix 'I'.

13. PROCEDURES/MODES OF APPLICATIONS.

- (a) Applications for grant of respective subsidies shall be made as specified under 4(C), 5(C), 6(C), 7(C), 8(C), 9(C), 10(C), 11(C), or 12(C).
- (b) Each and every application shall be supported by the relevant voucher (s)/receipt(s) and other necessary certificates/documents as specified in the respective prescribed application forms under Appendix A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H or I.
- (c) On receipt of application, necessary inquiry/verification will be made by the concerned District Office and if found eligible, the original copy of the application with its enclosures will be forwarded to the Director of Industries with recommendation alongwith a consolidated list.

14. SELECTION AND SANCTION.

- (a) There shall be a State Level Committee for each and every Incentive/Subsidy scheme constituted by the Government as specified under 4(D), 5(D), 6(D), 7(D), 8(D), 9(D), 10(D), 11(D) and 12(D) for advising and assisting the Government in the selection of applicants eligible for the subsidies.
- (b) The Director of Industries will prepare consolidated statements of the cases proposed in order of merit for consideration of granting subsidy and will place before the committee for scrutiny and approval. The Committee will scrutinise the applications and select the applicants who are eligible for the subsidy and also set guidelines and priorities in selecting applicants. On the basis of recommendation of the Committee the Director of Industries shall submit to the Government the proposal for sanction of the subsidy clearly indicating the names of individual units and amounts of subsidy recommended against each unit supported by a copy of the minutes of the Committee.

- (c) The case of the eligible units left out, if any, due to limitation of budget provision in a particular year, shall be considered on the basis of priority in the next financial year.

15. DISBURSEMENT

On obtaining sanction, the Director of Industries will draw the amount and transfer to the concerned District Officer through cheque/Bank Draft who will ultimately disburse to the concerned industrial units.

The District Officer disbursing the subsidy shall maintain separate Registers for each and every Incentive/Subsidy scheme in which he shall enter the names of individual units receiving the subsidy with amounts of subsidised received.

16. CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF SUBSIDY

- (a) The grantee receiving the subsidy shall give an undertaking (in Appendix 'J' to the effect that he/she will continue to run the unit for a period as specified in the respective aforementioned subsidy rules after receiving the subsidy.
- (b) In the event of non-fulfilment of the above condition, the entire subsidy amount disbursed to the unit shall be refundable to the Government by the grantee.
- (c) The grantee shall make declaration (In Appendix 'K') that in the event of false informations and use of fake documents, the entire subsidy amount disbursed to the unit shall be refundable to the Government by the grantee.

17. INTERPRETATION

In any matter of a doubt arising out of any of these rules the interpretation by and decision of the Director of Industries shall be final.
