In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 4 (1) of the Mizoram (Election to the Village Councils) Rules, 1974 as adapted, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to appoint the Deputy Commissioners, Aizawl and Lunglei Districts as Electoral Registration Officers for the Village Council elections within their respective jurisdiction.

Further, in exercise of the above said Rule, the Governor of Mizoram is also pleased to appoint the DLAOs of Aizawl and Lunglei Districts as Assistant Electoral Registration Officers to assist the Electoral Registration Officer in the performance of their functions within their respective Districts.

In exercise of the powers conferred by para 2 of Sub-section 3 of the Lushai Hills District (House site) Act, 1953, the Government of Mizoram hereby declares the whole area of "Vawngawn Ram Durtlang" as a Protected Area for public purpose with effect from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

The Government of Mizoram, further, declares that the land status, transfer of ownership, extension and alteration of land in any form are also restricted to with immediate effect.
