No. K-16011/1/91-REV, the 30th March, 1992. Pursuance to the Government's decision, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to notify that within the Village Council area, there will be reserved land for the purpose of public Cattle Grazing Ground which will be separately demarcated as and when considered necessary by the Government.

The Governor of Mizoram is further pleased to declare that the Local Administration Department will function as a nodal Department and such demarcated land shall be granted on lease basis which will be utilised by Village Council concerned for the upkeep and maintenance of the Cattle Grazing Ground. Such creation of reserved land will be initiated by the Local Administration Department for the villages depending upon the size of casttle population and then move Revenue Department for issue of Departmental Land Lease.

The Local Administration Department will coordinate the Departments of A.H. & Vety. and Water & Soil Conservation for technical guidance and financial assistance respectively.

This Notification will take immediate effect until the above Notification is translated in to Acts, Rules or Regulation by the Local Administration Department.
