NOTIFICATION

No. 56/92. Waereas, the Election Commission has, vide its Order dated 13.05.1992, decided that the Indian Congress (Socialist Sarat Chandra Sinha) shall be known, and called, as Indian Congress (Socialist), that it shall be recognised as a State party in the States of Kerala and Manipur and that the Symbol 'Charkha' shall be reserved for it in the said States.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-clause (b) of clause (l) of paragraph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, the Election Commission hereby makes the following further amendments in its Notification No. 56/91, dated 19th April, 1991, as amended from time to time, namely:—

In Table 2 appended to the said Notification, against the States of Kerela and Manipur.

(i) the entries "Indian Congress (Socialist Sarat Chandra Sinha)" and "Charkha within a rectangle" in columns 2 and 3 shall be substituted by the entries "Indian Congress (Socialist)" and "Charkha" respectively.
