THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE CONSERVATION (TRAVEL)  
TAX ABOLITION ORDINANCE, 1992  
NO. 8 OF 1992

Promulgated by the President in the Forty-third Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance to amend the Finance Act, 1987.

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) ~~This Ordinance may be called the Foreign~~ Short title  
Exchange Conservation (Travel) Tax Abolition Ordinance, 1992. and com-  
mencement.

(2) It shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1992.

Omission of Chapter V of Finance Act, 1987. 2. Chapter V of the Finance Act, 1987, relating to the Foreign Exchange Conservation (Travel) Tax, shall be omitted.

THE CAPITAL ISSUES (CONTROL) REPEAL ORDINANCE, 1992  
No. 9 OF 1992

Promulgated by the President in the Forty-third Year of the Republic of India

An Ordinance to repeal the Capital Issues (Control) Act, 1947

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Capital Issues (Control) Repeal Ordinance, 1992. Short title and commencement.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.

Repeal of Act 29 of 1947. 2. The Capital Issues (Control) Act, 1947 is hereby repealed.
