### NOTIFICATION

No. A. 33023/1/84-HFW, the 26th June, 1992. Whereas the Governor is of the opinion that prosecution of further studies by Medical Officers is to be encouraged in order to obtain more Specialists in various Medical disciplines to respond the public demands in the State;

And whereas the studies of Housemanship in the suitable discipline will facilitate admission to post graduate courses for those medical graduates who are interested to prosecute further studies;

And whereas the Medical Council of India has consented to recognise non-teaching Civil Hospital, Aizawl for studies of such housemanship course;

Now, therefore, in the interest of public service, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules for Selection etc. for Housemanship at Civil Hospital, Aizawl as follows namely :-

Short title and commencement. 1. (a) These rules may be called the Mizoram Health and Family Welfare (Selection of candidates for prosecuting Housemanship Course) Rules, 1991.

(b) It shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Definitions 2. In these rules unless the context otherwise requires,

(a) "Bond" means contract bond to be executed by selected candidates in accordance with Provision of Rule 12

(b) "Course" means any course of speciality as mentioned under rule 5;

(c) "Emolument" means salary to be paid to the Housemen who are in the service of the Government;

- (d) "Government" means the the Government of Mizoram;
- (e) "Houseman" means the Selected candidate for the courses who executed the bond and joined the course;
- (f) "Selection Committee" means a selection Committee to select candidates for Housemanship course under rule 7.

3. (1) Application for Housemanship course shall be invited by the Secretary to Government of Mizoram, Health and Family Welfare Department by advertisement giving reasonable time.

(2) Application for selection of House Job courses in a prescribed form at Appendix III shall be submitted to the Secretary to Government of Mizoram, Health & Family Welfare Department.

(3) A candidate may apply for a maximum of two Specialities and shall apply in one form giving his/her choices in order of preference.

(4) Candidates in employment must send their application through proper channel.

(5) Applications which are incomplete and/or received after the stipulated time in the advertisement shall not be considered.

4. (1) A candidate must possess the degree of a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery from a recognised Medical University of India as enlisted in the First Schedule and Part I of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and permanent Registration Certificate.

(2) The Candidates who had failed more than twice in the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery Examinations shall not be eligible for admission.

(3) The Candidates who have already done/doing the course in any subject shall not be considered for admission.

5. The number of seats available at present which may be increased or decreased from time to time against each speciality are as follows, namely :-

Medicine	—	3
Obstetrics & Gynaecology	—	1
Ophthalmology	—	1
Surgery	—	2
Radiology	—	1

- Duration of the Course and Period of Registration 6. (1) The period of registration will be one year.
- (2) At the end of the first six months of the admission each Houseman will be given objective clinical assessment. The Houseman may not be allowed to continue further studies in case his performance is found to be unsatisfactory.
- Selection Committee 7. There will be a Selection Committee consisting of the following members and the selection of the Committee shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the various courses namely :
1. Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department. - Chairman
  2. Medical Superintendent. - Member
  3. Senior-most specialist in the line, Civil Hospital Aizawl. - Member
  4. Director of Health Services - Member-Secretary
- Method of Selection 8. (a) The Candidates who obtained Bachelor of Medicines and Bachelor of Surgery degree, have completed at least one year's Internship and possessed Permanent Registration Certificate and have no failure more than twice in Bachelor of Medicines and Bachelor of Surgery Examinations will only be selected;
- (b) A deduction of one percent and three percent marks respectively shall be made from the aggregate percentage for first and second failures for calculating marks for determining eligibility;
- (c) The candidates who are in the service of the Government for three years and above five years and above shall be given additional marks upto two percent and three percent respectively and the candidates who were sponsored for studies of Bachelor of Medicines and Bachelor of Surgery by the Government shall be given additional marks of two percent for calculating the percentage of marks for eligibility determination.
- Accommodation 9. (a) The Houseman will be required to stay in the room/seat provided in the Hospital staff quarter, a single or double bedded room with his Co-Housemen with free rental charges but such a housemen shall have to pay the electric charges.
- (b) No accommodation for Houseman with his/her family will be provided.
- Date of joining 10. (a) The selected candidates must join the courses in the date stipulated in the letter of selection failing which the selection will automatically stand cancelled and such seats shall then be offered to the candidates on the waiting list in order of merit.

- Medical examination 11. No selected candidates will be permitted to join the course unless declared medically fit by the Medical practitioner.
- Emoluments 12. Each Houseman who is not in Govt. service will be engaged on contract service for a period of one year and during such a period of engagement he shall entitle for fixed payment of emoluments at the scale of Rs. 2200/-per month and no separate emolument will be paid to those houseman who are already in the Government service.
- Service condition 13. (1) The Houseman who are not in the service of the Government cannot claim the services rendered as Houseman for the purpose of counting seniority in their future services and postings.
- (2) No Houseman can continue further studies if recruited into Government service during the pendency of the agreement/Course.
- (3) The service of Houseman of the inservice personnel will be treated as on duty.
- (4) Private practice in any form during the pendency of the course is prohibited for Houseman.
- (5) All Houseman shall maintain good conduct, attend their assignments regularly and abide by the regulations of the Institutions.

## APPENDIX I

### AGREEMENT FOR HOUSEMAN

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ one thousand nine hundred and \_\_\_\_\_ between Dr \_\_\_\_\_ s/o \_\_\_\_\_ Resident of \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter called the Houseman) on the one part and the Govt. of Mizoram (hereinafter called the Government) of the other part.

WHEREAS the Government intends to appoint the person mention in the first part as Houseman for a period of one year commencing from the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 199\_\_\_\_\_.

AND WHEREAS it has been agreed by and/between the parties hereto that the Houseman shall serve the Government on the terms and conditions herein contained.

NOW THESE PRESENTS WITHNESSETH and the parties hereto respectively agree as follows:-

1. The Houseman shall submit himself/herself to the order of the Institute and Officers and authorised persons under whom he may from time to time be placed by the Medical Superintendent, Civil Hospital, Aizawl and shall serve as Houseman until his services are terminated.

2. The services of the Houseman may be terminated as follows :-

(i) By the Government without any previous notice or assigning any reason thereof, if the Government is satisfied on medical evidence that the Houseman is not fit and is likely for a considerable period to continue unfit by reason of ill-health for the discharge of his duties. The decision of the Government shall be conclusive and binding on him/her.

(ii) By the Government without any previous notice or assigning any reason thereof, if the houseman be guilty of any in-subordination, intemperance or other misconduct or any breach or non performance of any of the provisions of the agreement or of any rules pertaining to the Institute and the decision of the Government shall be conclusive/binding on him/her.

(iii) By thirty days notice in writing given at any time during service under this agreement by the Government or its authorised Officer to him without cause assigned.

**PROVIDED ALWAYS** that the Government in lieu of any notice herein provided give Houseman a sum equivalent to the amount of salary for one month or shorter notice than 30 days if it pay him a sum equal to the amount of his salary for the period by which such notice fall short of 30 days. The salary for the purpose of the provision shall mean the salary/Emolument of the Houseman would be receiving under Clause 6 of this agreement.

3. If the Houseman is suspended in connection with any investigation into his conduct or absented himself/herself from duties without authority, he/she or shall not be entitled to any emoluments/Salary during such period.

4. The Housemen shall devote his/her whole time to the duties of the said service and shall not engage directly or indirectly, in any trade, business, occupation or profession (including any private practice). On his/her own account and shall not absent himself/herself from his/her duties without having first obtained permission from the Medical Superintendent, Civil Hospital, Aizawl.

5. The Houseman shall not except as provided in this Agreement, resign his/her appointment without completing the course to which he/she has been admitted by the Government. Defaulter shall be liable to pay the sum of Rs 2000/-only to the Government as compensation besides forfeiture of his/her emoluments/stipend for the month in which he/she leaves the course.

6. With effect from ———day of———19——— The Government shall pay the houseman so long as he/she remains in the said service and actually performed his/her duties as aforesaid at the fixed monthly rate of Rs.2200/-per month for Housemen who are not in the service of the Government and full pay and allowances without daily allowance for Housemen who are inservice of the Government.

7. The Houseman shall be required to stay in the room/seat provided in the Hospital staff quarter single or double with Co-Housemen with free rental charge but each houseman shall pay the electric charges. No accommodation for Housemen with his/ her family will be provided.

8. Besides academic working in pursuance of this course, the Houseman shall carry out all the duties and responsibilities required for him/her to be assigned and undertaken to him/ her by the Medical Superintendent where he/she will be placed in the discharge of the patient care and maintenance of records and such other clinical and technical duties as may be assigned to him/ her by aforesaid authority from time to time in the interest of effective patient care and running of the Hospital. The decision of Medical Superintendent, Civil Hospital, Aizawl as to whether the Housemen were satisfactorily carrying out all the responsibilities aforesaid shall be final and binding on the Houseman.

9. The working hours of the Houseman will not normally exceed continuous duties for more than 12 hours on a day, subject to such exigencies as may arise where he/she may be placed and in this respect also, the decision of the Medical Superintendent, Civil Hospital, Aizawl shall be final and binding on the Houseman.

10. The Houseman shall be liable to be on call duty for 24 hours.

11. During the terms of deployment the Houseman shall be entitled to 12 days casual leave.

12. The Housemen shall not be allowed to apply for Job position/assignment elsewhere during the pendency of the course and such application shall not be forwarded during the validity of agreement.

13. The Houseman shall not be issued certificate/testimonial of any kind bearing evidence of satisfactory work, experience, performance etc. in case of the discontinuation of his/her course.
